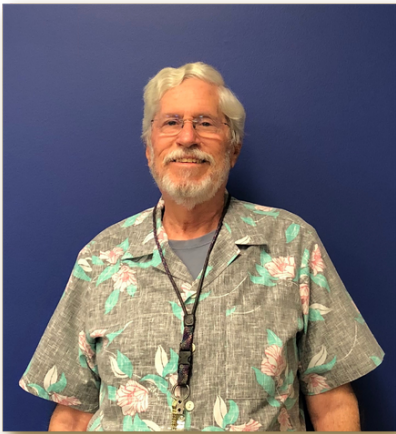


Mission

ONT Continues to Beat Pre-Pandemic Passenger Totals

October set a new high for ONT, as it was the busiest month since the return to local ownership in 2016! Over 541,000 passengers came through in the month, marking the eighth straight month of beating pre-pandemic passenger totals, and the sixth straight month of more than 500,000 passengers.

Thanksgiving numbers are primed to break pre-pandemic numbers as well.

During the holiday travel period of Friday,

November 18 through Monday, November 28, airlines at ONT are offering more than 229,000 seats and expecting an average of 83% of them to be full. This will make it a very busy time, which is good for the airport.

And still, ONT prides itself on speed and convenience, even as it gets busier. If any Friends are looking to travel in November and December, it helps to travel out of ONT!

coordination, Ontario International Airport is launching ONT+: a free service where you can visit the terminals without having purchased a flight!

You have to apply online within seven days of your visit, and choose the date and time you'd like to visit. Once you receive an email confirming that you're approved, then you'll show up and go through the TSA line the same way you would if you were a passenger. It's fast and easy, and an exciting way to get to see the great features of ONT better!
