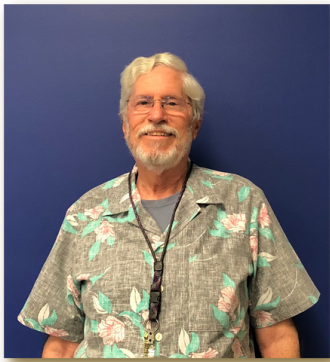


Mission

CAPA Americas Aviation Summit Was a Great Success

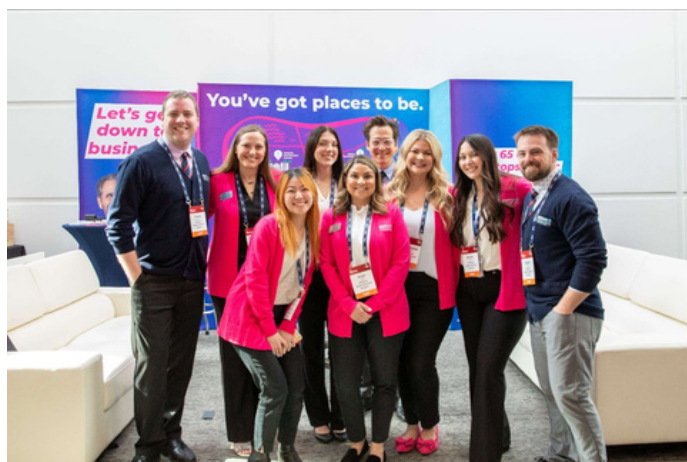
