Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Executive Director Gina Marie Lindsey announced that after a 39-year career, 33 working in the aviation industry, she will retire. Telling staff "it is time for me to move on to other adventures," Lindsey discussed her retirement with Mayor Eric Garcetti and Board of Airport Commissioners President Sean Burton and says she will stay on into the spring to ensure a smooth transition to new leadership.

The Los Angeles Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) unanimously approved the nomination of Oakland International Airport Director Deborah Ale Flint as the next executive director of Los Angeles World Airports.
