ONT: Optimism for 2021

In the closing days of the year - what many consider the worst in the history of commercial aviation - officials noted ONT's emerging recovery, among the quickest of U.S. airports, and the recently announced addition or resumption of service to key destinations. Despite the immediate challenges in the early stages of the pandemic, there were many encouraging signs:

- ONT recorded six straight months of traffic growth between April and October, regaining almost 50% of passenger volume compared to 2019.
- ONT launched an airport-wide initiative, ONTo What Matters Most, bringing life to the Airport's mission of providing a clean and safe journey that connects people, places and experiences.
- Airlines resumed or initiated new service from ONT to five destinations in 2020 including Atlanta, Chicago (Midway), Houston (Intercontinental) Seattle and Mexico City.

ONTo Wearing a Face Mask

Prepare for take-off by ensuring you have a mandatory face covering at all times while at the airport. ONT has you covered with Personal Protective Equipment vending machines throughout each terminals. These vending machines have hand sanitizer, gloves, and face masks available for purchase on the fly. Touchless hand sanitizer stations are everywhere throughout the terminals and specialty placed decals as a friendly reminder to maintain a safe distance from one another.
