

# **AIRPORT NEWS**

#### New Construction at ONT

There are three major projects under construction at the airport. First is the demolition of the West Cargo Ramp as the start of the FecEx expansion. Second is the Taxiway G improvement project that repaves the east section of the TWY along with gates 1, 2 & 3 by terminal one. Third is a new Cargo Complex that is for the Southwest and MTS cargo relocation.
