From Fr. Mike's Desk

In the Nazi concentration camp of Auschwitz, there was a Polish priest Maximilian Kolbe, who was arrested, because he criticized the Nazi regime. One of the prisoners escaped from the camp, so the commandant, to punish the prisoners, and to stop future escapes, ordered ten prisoners to be starved to death. One of the ten was a young man with a wife and children. When his number was called out, Fr. Kolbe stepped forward and insisted on taking his place. In the death cell, Fr. Kolbe helped the others prepare for death, however, he was the last to die and his death was taking far too long for the Nazis, so they poisoned him. After Kolbe's death, one could see a picture of Jesus on the Cross scratched into the walls by his fingernails.

How is it that Saint Maximilian Kolbe was able to make this great gift of sacrifice for someone he did not know? One could say, "Well he was a priest, what else would you expect?" And while it is true that many bishops, priests, deacons, religious sisters, and brothers have done something like this, it is also true that many could not. St. Maximilian focused not on himself, but as we saw in the above account, he focused on Jesus as seen in the picture he scratched on the cell's wall. Kolbe heard the words of John the Baptist, "*Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.*"

What does John mean by the expression, The Lamb of God? According to Scripture Scholars, the Lamb of God could have several meanings. One could be the Lamb of the Suffering Servant found in the Prophet Isaiah, or as John the Evangelist points out, in his Passion Account, the Passover/Paschal Lamb. John leaves us with the impression that Jesus replaces those lambs and is now the one, true Paschal Lamb; whose sacrifice on the Cross destroys all sin, darkness, and spiritual death.

It is because of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection that we can face terrible situations and always know that God is with us. Yet sometimes we feel that God has abandoned us, or just is not listening to us. Remember, He truly is listening, and He is always with us, especially when we think He is not. How do we know this, and can we trust this? It is easy, just keep in mind how God loves us, how much Jesus has given for us so that we may have life, and not just life, but Eternal Life!

During the last week of January, we will join with the Church throughout the country to celebrate **Catholic Schools Week**. We are blessed in our parish with our wonderful and beautiful Saint Edward's School. While sending your children to our school does involve some sacrifice, the benefits that your children will gain and that you will gain will last a lifetime. Our students learn more than the traditional three 'Rs, they have wonderful computer facilities, a refurbished science lab, beautiful classrooms, and some of the best teachers, aides, staff, and principal on Long Island. They also will gain one thing that they will never learn about in any public school and that is their Catholic Faith. Please consider our school and during Catholic Schools Week you can visit the school and see it in action. 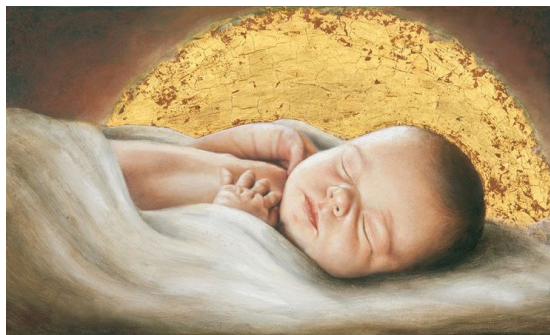

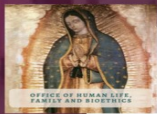

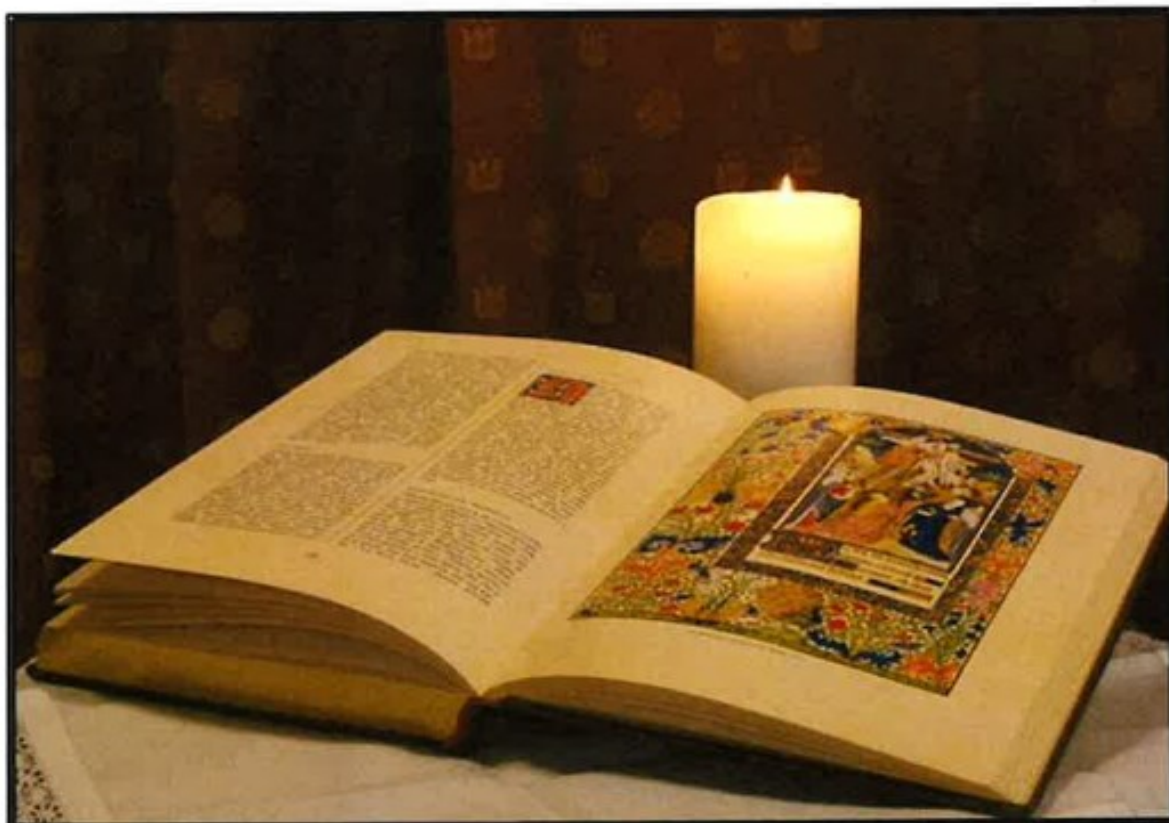
