From Fr. Mike's Desk

During the Eucharistic Prayer, we recite the Mystery of Faith, right after the Consecration of the Bread and Wine as they are now the Body and Blood of Christ. We now may say, "We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again." These are the words we use now, as they are closer to the words said in Latin. However, we used to say, "Christ as died, Christ has Risen, Christ will come again." The words remind us of what we are concentrating on during these first two Sundays of Advent, especially for this second week.

In the reading from Isaiah, we are told of the First Coming, when he tells the people that they can take comfort in the Lord who is about to set them free from captivity from Babylon. God will return them to Israel so that they may be called to God's mountaintop. They will be heralds of the Good News, and the Divine Light will shine from them, as the Messiah will empower them when He comes. The First Coming is also proclaimed in the appearance of John the Baptist. John reminds us that he is the voice crying out in the wilderness (as seen in the sayings of Isaiah) who is preparing the way of the Lord. He will tell us that he baptizes with water, but the one to follow will baptize with the Holy Spirit.

The Second Coming of Christ is seen in today's second reading; the Second Letter of Saint Peter. As Peter writes, "But according to his promise we await a new heaven and a new earth." St. Peter writes to an audience, who like many today, did not believe that Christ would be coming again. As you may recall, the early Church, even St. Paul, believed that Christ's return would be almost immediate. When His coming delayed, some began to believe that He would never come back. Peter is warning people not to make this same mistake; as he says, "...whether it takes one hundred years or one thousand years, Christ will return in His own time, and He will indeed come to judge the living and the dead. As he writes, "But the day of the Lord will come like a thief." So be ready, for we do not know the time or day when the Scriptures will be fulfilled.

How will Christ find us when He returns? Will He find us living according to the contemporary wisdom of the modern world that calls us away from our true life with God? St. Peter gives us good advice when it comes to waiting for the Second Coming as he writes, "Therefore, beloved, since you await these things, be eager to be found without spot or blemish before Him at peace." What St. Peter writes about can be a real problem for us here as so many do not believe that Christ will return at the end of the world. It has been 2,024 years but remember who it is who made the promise. It is none other than Jesus the Son of God, God made one of us. He is the Living Word of God, so what He says is the truth. So be ready!

Here are some of the happenings during Advent. On Sunday, December 17th we will have our Youth Choir Christmas Concert in the Church, at a time to be announced, Tuesday, December 12th, at 8:00 PM we will have Advent Lessons and Carols, on Sunday, December 17th at 3:00 PM, our annual Mass for Deceased Children. On Wednesday, December 19th from 2:00 - 3:00 PM and 7:00 - 9:00 PM there will be Advent Confessions in preparation for Christmas.

Our Christmas Eve and Day Schedule goes as follows: Sunday, December 24th the Fourth Sunday of Advent we will have our usual Saturday Night/Sunday Morning Masses. Namely, Saturday at 5:00 PM, Sunday Morning at 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, and 11:30 AM. As we move into the day the Masses will be for Christmas Eve and Day. Sunday, December 24th Christmas Eve.: 4:00 PM Mass with Children's Choir in the Church. Likewise we will have 4:00 PM Mass in the Gym. 6:00 PM Mass, 8:00 PM Mass, and 12:00 Midnight are each in the Church. On Monday Christmas Day, our Mass Schedule will be 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 11:30 AM and the final Mass being 1:00 PM all in the Church. There will be no Evening Mass on Christmas Day.

Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

As you prepare your home for a joyous Christmas with family and friends, allow yourself time to prepare your heart for Christ the Lord. Join fellow parishioners in prayer, liturgy, meditation, reconciliation, scripture and music.






