From Fr. Mike's Desk

This week we continue with John the Baptist, only this week we are looking at him through the Gospel of John. Recall John's Gospel does not start with the stable at Bethlehem, as Matthew and Luke do, or even with John the Baptist as Mark's Gospel begins. No, John begins in Heaven, and in his prologue, we read that Christ, or the Son of God, existed from the beginning (realize that beginning is not the best word to use) with the Father and the Holy Spirit. It is this preexistent Second Person of the Blessed Trinity which John calls the Word or Logos in Greek, which came down from Heaven. The Divine Logos becomes one of us in the person of Jesus, and He is the light of the Father that the darkness of evil cannot and will not overtake. The Word made Flesh is the one John was sent to give testimony to.

Once again, we see the forerunner preparing the way of the Lord, but he does make sure that no one confuses him with the Messiah. John gave the officials this answer when they asked if he was the Messiah. No, I am not. He continued with, "I baptize with water, but there is one among you whom you do not recognize, the one who is coming after me whose sandal strap I am unworthy to untie." John wants no mistake about who he is and who it is that comes after him.

John's preaching was not just for the people of 2,024 years ago, it is for us as well. As we saw last week, we are like wise to prepare the way of the Lord and knock down any barriers that prevent others or us from coming closer to Christ. We too must listen to John, but unlike those of 2,024 years ago, we are to join John in testifying to the Light. But how do we do this? We can do this when we realize that the Spirit of the Lord is upon us and He has anointed us to heal the brokenhearted and bring glad tidings to the poor. With the Holy Spirit's power, we can achieve anything! Keep in mind that when we are doing this, we should not get in the way of the Holy Spirit. Follow Paul's advice in his Letter to the Thessalonians, to give thanks to God for having given us life, through Christ and saving us from the darkness.

Here are some of the happenings during Advent. on Sunday, December 17th at 3:00 PM, there will be our annual Mass for Deceased Children. On Wednesday, December 19th from 2:00 to 3:00 PM and from 7:00 to 9:00 PM will be Advent Confessions in preparation for Christmas. Our Christmas Eve and Day Schedule goes as follows: **Sunday, December 24th the Fourth Sunday of Advent** we will have our usual Saturday Night/Sunday Morning Masses. Namely, Saturday, at 5:00 PM, Sunday Morning at 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, and 11:30 AM. As we move into the day the Masses will be for Christmas Eve and Day, **Sunday, December 24th - Christmas Eve:** 4:00 PM Mass with the Children's Choir in the Church, likewise we will have 4:00 PM Mass in the Gym, and 6:00 PM Mass, 8:00 PM Mass,

and 12:00 Midnight all in the Church. On Monday, Christmas Day our Mass Schedule will be 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM, 11:30 AM and the final Mass being 1:00 PM, all in the Church. There will be no Evening Mass on Christmas Day.

As you know, the Christmas Collection is one of the most important collections here in our beautiful parish. Through this collection and your extreme generosity, we can pay many of the bills that we incur during the year. In the past, you have been exceedingly kind to our dear parish, and I thank you from the bottom of my heart. This year we are especially in need, and we cannot keep ourselves going without your help. Thank you for your generous heart and helping us.


