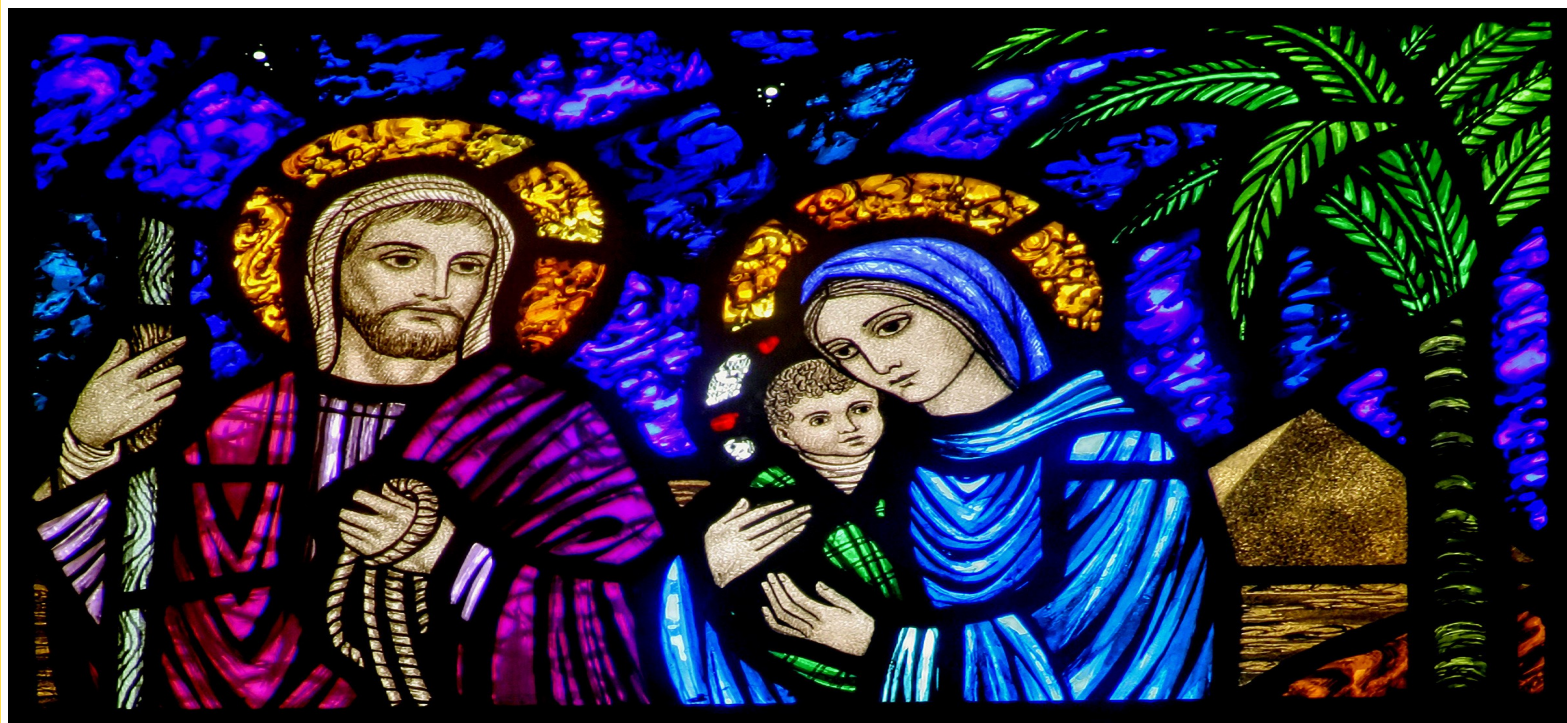

From Fr. Mike's Desk

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, many times we know that our calling of these three holy people is not always for a holy reason. In fact, many times the name of the Holy Family is invoked for reasons that should be reserved for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. However, today we say the names of the members of the Holy Family with immense joy and hope as we celebrate their lives in Nazareth.

Today we hear Luke's account of how Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the Temple for their purification according to the Law of Moses. While there, a man named Simeon, who was righteous and devout, and was awaiting the Consolation of Israel, came upon them. Filled with the Holy Spirit, Simeon was told that he would not see death before he saw the Christ. He took the infant in his arms and said, "Now, master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word." He then proceeded to say what this child would accomplish in His life. Jesus would be a light of revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of His people Israel. Likewise, He will be a sign of contradiction, and many will fall and rise in Israel because of Him. Simeon was telling our Dear Blessed Mother and St. Joseph, that their child would transform not just Israel, but the entire world, not just one people, but also humanity.

St. Paul in his Letter to the Colossians, tells us that we should take all that Christ has gained for us, and put it into action when it comes to our families and all the members of the community. Paul tells us to put heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with and forgiving one another. If one has a grievance against another, we must forgive one another, just as God has forgiven us. In addition, one must put on love, which is the bond of perfection and always allows the peace of Christ to control our hearts. Paul tells us to, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly..." To top it off, Paul tells us, "And whatever you do in word or deed, do everything in the name of Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Great goals to strive for and with the help of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we can do it. We close with a prayer for families based on a prayer written by Pope Pius XII.

O Lord, God of goodness and mercy, who amid an evil and sinful world has presented to the society of the redeemed the Holy Family of Nazareth as a spotless mirror of piety, justice, and love. Behold

how the family is being undermined on all sides, every effort being made to desecrate it, by stripping it of faith, religion, and morals. Come and stir up champions of the family. Empower the modern apostles so that in Thy Name, bearing the message of Jesus Christ and exhibiting holiness of life, they may revive fidelity for married couples, the exercise of authority by parents, and obedience on the part of children. Grant also through the efforts of these apostles that families may have many blessings and become an object of esteem and love. It is through the example of the model of Nazareth that the Christian Family is to be restored in Jesus Christ. Let every household be a sanctuary, rekindled in the flame of faith, and be a place where there is patience in adversity and harmony in all things. Allow the family to be a haven of rest against life's burdens...Amen.

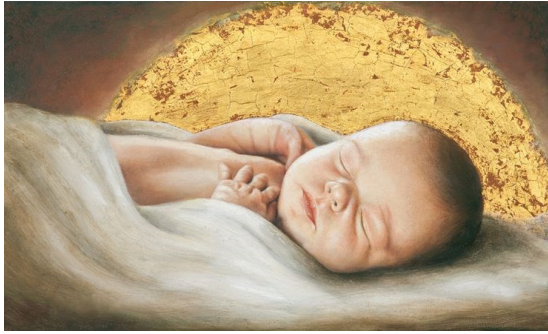
If we believe Jesus to be the 'King of the Universe', in which ways can we show our respect? What gifts might we offer to our Savior?

Where there is kindness there is goodness; where there is goodness there is God.

The goodness of the parishioners of St. Edward Confessor Church and the Syosset community has changed the lives of so many here in Syosset and beyond. For many of our pantry families, the increasing cost of living has made their difficult life circumstances more of a burden. Between the financial hardship and ongoing health related issues, life leaves them feeling hopeless and abandoned by God. The volunteers in both the Parish Social Ministry and our St. Vincent DePaul Conference help the less fortunate to witness the goodness of God.

Goodness is needed in the today's world. The world is full of need and longing. A gentleman from the neighborhood called me asking for a coat after we already gave away all the coats. I remembered him from the time we were open during the pandemic. I told him I would get him a coat. Two weeks later, he came by to pick up the new coat and he said "I am going to cry. I was so surprised to get a phone call from you about the coat. At first I thought it was a prank call." I also gave him a warm hat and offered him some food. I told him if he needed any assistance to please come by, we are here for you.

Another neighbor in need is helping her mentally ill sister to keep food on the shelves and to keep her apartment. I had not seen her either since the pandemic. I welcomed her back. We talked a while about the challenges of caring for a sibling with a disability. She was grateful for the food and especially to have someone who would listen to her. The power of simple goodness is astonishing.

The kindness of the parishioners continues to change lives by comforting someone who is sick or grieving, with prayers and with handmade prayer shawls. We are so fortunate to have parishioners who continue to volunteer their time to bring Communion to the Sick in Syosset Hospital, the elderly living in the nearby nursing homes and the homebound. We visit Cold Spring Hills Nursing Home with a small group of dedicated volunteers. Residents warmly welcome us and greet us with joy to receive Jesus and hear the Word of God. In October, we brought back the Hot Lunch Program for the residents living in the TOB Housing in town. Volunteers cook and serve the hot lunch. Residents come to the community room to enjoy a delicious meal and fellowship. We have an amazing outreach ministry here at St. Edward Confessor Church; every volunteer works tirelessly to give of their time to help our neighbors in need.

Let's continue to allow God to fill us with His goodness so together we can go out and astonish the world with more kindness and compassion. Unleash your goodness!

Catholic Ministries Appeal

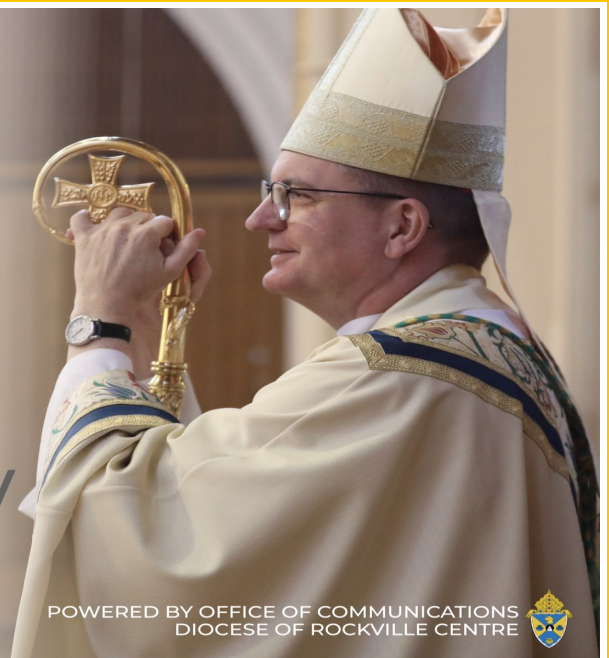
