Repeal **Death Tax.** In 2020, **Prop 19**, was deceptively promoted to help seniors and fire victims. But it also repealed the 1978 **Prop 13** provision that allowed family homes to be passed to children (or grandchildren if parents are deceased) without being reassessed. Goto www.hjta.org to find a petition to repeal **Prop 19**. You have to fill-in and sign both the **Petition** and the **Declaration of Circulator**. Deadline is 1/16/2024.
