Happy New Year! Thanks to all YCRCC members for making 2023 a huge success. Let's make 2024 even better. With your help, it will happen! There's a tremendous amount of work to do this election year.

Repeal Death Tax. In 2020, Prop 19 repealed the 1978 Prop 13 provision that allowed family homes and businesses (up to the factored basis value plus \$1M) to be passed to children (or grandchildren if parents are deceased) without being reassessed. If you haven't already signed the petition to repeal Prop 19, go to www.hjta.org to find a petition form for January. You have to fill in and sign both the Petition and the Declaration of the Petition circulator. The deadline for getting the petition to the **Howard Jarvis Taxpayer Association** is 1/16/2024.

Note: you must now use a petition that is specifically for the month of January 2024, which is available for downloading at the HJTA website.


