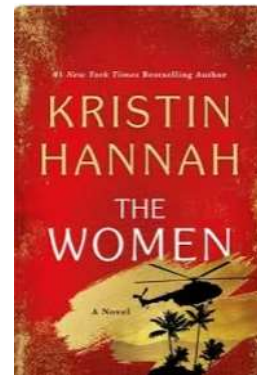
Many **YCRCC** members gathered signatures for initiatives to **Make Crime Illegal**, and to **Keep Boys Out Of Girl's Restrooms.**
