Scholarship Guidelines

TDHMA Scholarship Program

- Applicants must be a senior in high school or currently enrolled in an accredited High School and under the age of 25.
- Applicants must be a member of the TDHMA (family or individual) for a minimum of three years.
- Applicants must complete scholarship application and 500 word essay (How draft horses have influenced my life) for TDHMA Board of Directors approval
- Applications must be received by the secretary/treasurer on or before June 1st of each year.
- Applicant must be accepted and enrolled at an accredited university or trade school.
- Applicant may receive only one scholarship from the TDHMA.
- Scholarship is valid for 12 months from award date
- Recipients must provide student account number/ID number and address to the TDHMA Secretary/Treasurer for the scholarship fund to be mailed directly to the school.
- Scholarship is a maximum of \$1,000 based on board discretion and funds availability
