
From The Potentate Bob Giesler

For Richard, the museum is more than memorabilia of days gone by, but a living

showcase of a grand time in American life. Now Bennett, who never married, doesn't own a TV or a computer. He spends all of his time buying items for his extensive collection which has taken over this home including the kitchen, living room and several addon garages. Noble Don Campbell was in the pipe band as Pipe Sargent for 40 years. In that time, he made every single Shrine event and parade!




