
May Potentates Message

\$500 Burgers Help Kids To Be Kids

Helping kids to be kids was the message conveyed at the St. Croix Valley Shrine Clubs special \$500 Burger Night fundraiser held at Junior's in the Best Western Plus hotel in downtown River Falls on Tuesday, April 19th.

Rod Rommel, a member of the board of governors for the Shrine Hospital for Children in the Twin Cities, introduced Jeffrey Bruce, the director of Orthotics and Prosthetics at the Hospital. Bruce was invited to share with the audience how their contribution would be used to help fund a special Shoe Insert Carver, which was the goal of the fund raising event conducted by the Shrine Club.

In his role as director of the Pediatric Orthothic and Prosthetic Service (POPS) Jeff said he has the honor of seeing children who come in a wheelchair with one of many problems with legs, feet or spine either from birth defects or from accidents and see them run and play like other kids.

According to Jeff, the Hospital in the Twin Cities has handled 3000 cases this year, 300 of which required prosthetic devices. The Shriners Hospital for Children® in the Twin Cities has become a central fabrication location not only for the 5 practitioners in the Twin Cities, but also for 4 practitioners in Lexington, Kentucky.

The Hospital's carver unit is the size of a small car and when combined with state of the art computers, can take the carving of braces from 30 minutes to 8 minutes. It is far from

the days when the same project was measured in days.

The finished form can be turned out and tried out right away. According to Jeff, when these kids receive a brace they are sent out to play so the unit can be evaluated. He has observed that kids at play is the best test for the units he designs in concert with the staff. After all, says Bruce, "I want kids to be kids."

The POPS department at Shriners Hospital is currently working at 80% capacity, say Bruce, and they feel they have enough in their budget to add one more technician. The hospital also is doing electronically controlled knees similar to the units done for Veterans at Walter Reed.

Jeff indicated that this fundraising event will go a long way to help fund the carving unit. Those

units cost over \$44,000. Thanks to the generous donations from the people from the St. Croix Valley, that goal is closer.

Jeff Bruce urged anyone who wants to see this unit in action, to call him at the hospital and he would gladly give them a tour.

Grand and Glorious Order of the Hillbilly's




The Hillbilly's raise money for Shriners Hospital for Children and for the Hospital Transportation Fund.




