Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

(God shows up) Isa 6:6-7 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."

Sin does not keep God from us, sin just keeps us partnering with God to help the world.

Sin does not push God away from you. Sin draws Him to you, He knows that only His presence can change your life. God is not afraid of sin. He is afraid of you not dealing with your sin.

(God shows up) Act 9:5 And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.

Look at the statement God makes about Saul just a few days after knocking him off his horse.

Act 9:15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel.

God just wants to redeem us, love us and then send us out to do the same.
