## Spring & Summer Polices

As the weather gets warmer we want to take this time to let you know some of our Spring & Summer policies:

- \*We get MESSY! Please make sure that your child is wearing clothes to school that are comfortable and you are okay with getting a little dirty
- \* Closed toed shoes with backs are required to keep little toes safe. NO FLIP FLOPS!
- \* Girls must wear shorts, tights, or leggings under their skirts or dresses.
- \* We will put bug spray and/or sunscreen on your child with your permission. You must provide the bug spray and sunscreen yourself and fill out a permission form. Please make sure your child has it on before coming to school in the morning and we will reapply it in the afternoon when we go outside.



### Wednesday May 22nd:


"Workout Wednesday"- Wear your workout gear and we will have some fitness fun.
