Blast From The Past

Too Hooked to Quit
When NRHA Professional Jay Dee Anderson headed south from Wilsall, Montana, for his 15th NRHA Futurity, he figured it would be his last time showing at the major event. After making the Level 1 Open finals and tying for 11th aboard You Bet Your Quistor, he might have changed his tune a bit. "The horse I rode in the finals is the product of what we've bred here at home for the last 40 years," Anderson said. "He's a really nice-minded son of a stud that I own. I've also owned five generations on the bottom side."
Out of Suzette Chex, the dark bay gelding is by Skeets Conquistador, a son of NRHA \$2 Million Sire Conquistador Whiz. During the 2023 show season, Skeets Conquistador, a now-16-year-old stallion, added some \$18,000 in NRHA lifetime earnings to his record, which stands at \$120,000-plus.

"He's earned it all the hard way — \$500 at a time, and later in life," Anderson explained. "One of the best parts about this stud is that his colts are really smooth, which helps when you're 69 years old."
The oldest competitor in the Open finals this year and the second-oldest in the Open Futurity overall, Anderson earned a 212.5 worth \$2,369 (including nominator incentives). But advancing to the final day of the Futurity aboard You Bet Your Quistor meant far more.
"Everyone was making a big deal about how old I was, and it was kind of fun," Anderson said with a chuckle. "I had a lot of help from my sons. I rode with Jarvis [Anderson, an NRHA Professional] for

a week before I went to Oklahoma City, and I rode with Jared Leclair this summer for a bit to help me stay modern with my maneuvers so I could be competitive."
Both a judge and professional for many years, Anderson has seen things change over the decades when it comes to the sport of reining, but the craving and rush it gives never fades.
"There was some talk that this would be my last [NRHA] Futurity, but then I came home and rode my coming 3-year-olds, and they're pretty good so I can't quit," Anderson said. "I have a full brother to the one I made the finals on and another out of a Pretty Peppy Chec mare, and she feels special, so I'm definitely paying that one up for next year, too."

AQHYA Scholarship Program Guidelines

Complete a single application to determine your eligibility for available scholarship funding. Submitted materials must include a completed application form, picture of you and your horse, a copy of your AQHYA membership card (if applicable)

Eligibility of applicants is based on the individual criteria and requirements provided for each scholarship offered. Applications will be reviewed by the Montana Quarter Horse Association Board of Directors.

AWARD DISBURSEMENTS

All funds available for disbursement will be paid directly to the AQHA Show the recipient has attended. Written notification will be sent to the recipient prior to any action being taken.

1. Only one scholarship will be awarded per recipient.
2. Scholarship payments are disbursed directly to the horse show entity or organization holding the show.
3. Funds are distributed to Montana Quarter Horse Association Approved Shows only.
4. Funds are only applicable to entry fees, stall fees, office fees and or cattle fees.

In the event a scholarship disbursement is in excess of the recipient's outstanding bill or invoice, credit such funds to the recipient's next AQHA show within the State of Montana.

2 (TWO) \$500 Scholarships

- 1) \$500 awarded to a non-MQHYA member interested in participating in an MQHA/AQHA Show within the State of Montana
- 2) \$500 awarded to a current MQHYA participating in an MQHA/AQHA Show within the State of Montana.

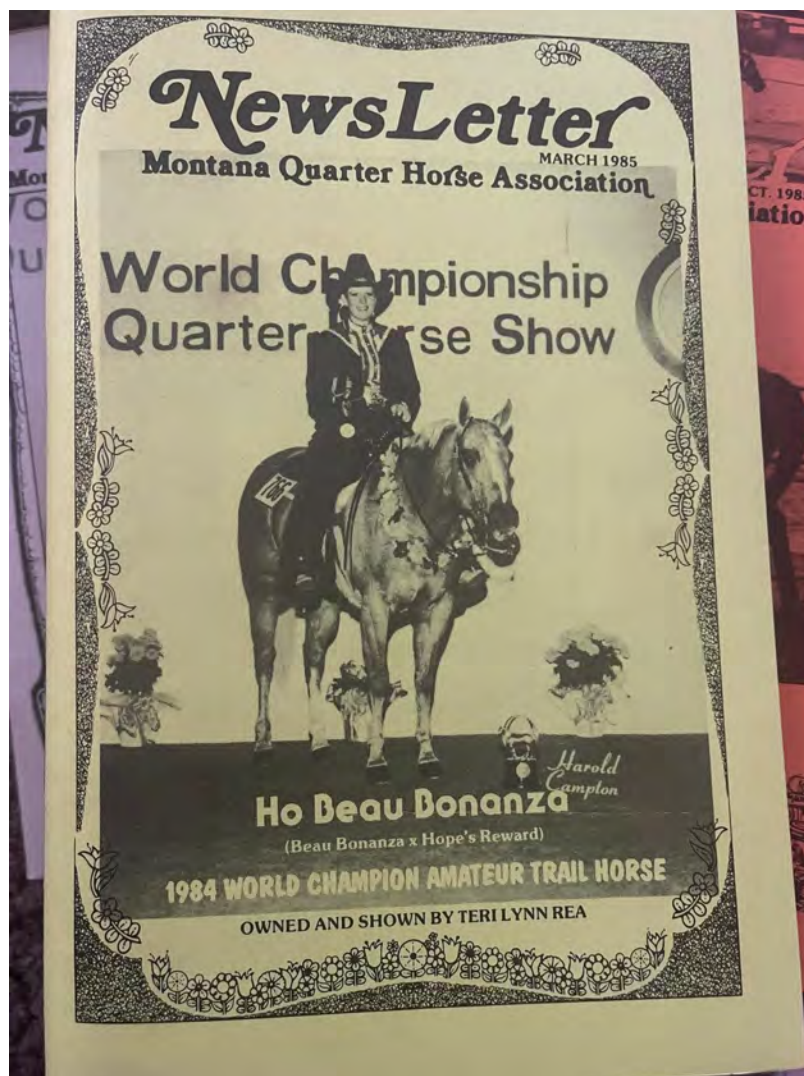

AQHA Rules: The below are paraphrased rules; please consult the 2023 AQHA Official Handbook of Rules and Regulations for the complete text.

Rookie Classes (SHW252.1): The exhibitor must have earned fewer than 10 lifetime points in that class in any division, and the horse must have earned fewer than 50 lifetime points in that class in any division.

Level 1 Classes (SHW250): To find your level, go to <https://aqhaservices.aqha.com/members/summaries/viewleveling>.

Level 1 Walk/Trot (SHW755): If a rider is entered into a walk-trot class that rider cannot show in the corresponding loping/cantering class at that show.

Ranch Riding (SHW416-418): A horse may not cross enter RR and WP. Hoof polish, banding/braiding, tail extensions are not allowed.

Show Rules:

Rookie classes with fewer than three exhibitors may run concurrently with the corresponding Level 1 class.

Starting at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, this clinic will cover AQHA rules and penalties as you practice classes for the show. Limited to 10 riders entered in the show. Rookies will get preference. Auditing is free.

PLEASURE VERSATILITY JACKPOT: Jackpot entrants will ride a Pattern (40%), then each group will work the rail for Pleasure (40%), then untack in the arena for Conformation (20%). **100% payout** of entry fees (the number of placings based on the number of entries). 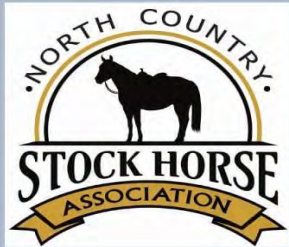

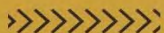
