The meeting was called to order by Chairman Diane Yates at 2:03 p.m.

a. Minutes of the July 21, 2015 Regular Board Meeting:

PROGRESS PAYMENT REQUEST:

a. Water Usage: Craig informed the Board of the water usage from 7/15-8/15/15 - 20.14 mg. Water usage down 20% from 2013.

b. New Sensor for Ewing Reservoir Level: Craig informed the Board the new level sensor has been installed. Sensor can be monitored from the iPhone.

c. Reservoir Level: Craig informed the Board the reservoir is at 2425.3 (five feet deeper than last year at this time).

d. Prop. 218 Article XIII D, Section 6: Craig informed the Board if the district is going to change our structure drastically the district needs to follow Prop. 218. This process will take longer.

PROGRESS PAYMENT REQUEST:

e. Water Rates: Craig suggested changing the minimum to "0" and raise the rates approximately \$3.00 assuming the amount of water sold is comparable to 2014. There needs to be a public hearing and the district would send out notices in November and December notifying customers of the changes in rates. The schedule would be in 2016-\$22.00; 2017 -\$25.00; 2018-\$28.00.

f. PERS Retirement System Payments Yearly/Monthly: Craig informed the Board PERS is charging the district 8.1/4% on our unfunded liability. The district owes approximately \$320,000 to be paid in the next twenty years. Craig will bring back information on paying off the unfunded liability and a proposal to pay it off.

g. Amortization Schedule for Unfunded Liability: Information only. No action needed.

h. PERS Contract Termination: Craig informed the Board what it would take to terminate the district's contract with PERS.

i. Surface Wash System for our Filters: Craig informed the Board Shane has automated the system.

j. Bullet hole in pump house at the Reservoir: Craig informed the Board someone had shot through the wall in the pump house and through the pipe. Craig will report back when he learns more.

k. Shane McDonald OIT Sewer: Craig informed the Board Shane is officially an OIT for Sewer.

1. Dirt Road Water Services: Craig informed the Board no payments have been received except for the payment from Evelyn Haynes.

m. Fire Update: Craig informed the Board on why the hydrants have been covered by trash bags.
