All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years and older must have a stallion certificate in order to participate. Gelding status must be reflected on the registration papers or on a show letter from the AMHA Office. All horses must be measured. (Exception: Per GR-020-G If you have a permanent measurement card issued by the AMHA for horses 60 months and older, that measurement card is valid for all AMHA Sanctioned shows, and you present the card and the horse to the person measuring. The measurement on the card will be the official measurement for that horse).

Valid AMHA registration, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. Out-of-state horses require Coggins within 6 months and health certificate within 45 days of show. Foals six months and younger do not require a Coggins if dam is negative.

General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the **2024** rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Association. All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Association.

This show has **two** judges. Points and awards will be awarded under each judge. "Show bucks" or ribbons will be awarded for $1^{st} - 6^{th}$. Championship ribbons will be awarded for all Championship classes.

Stabling: Barns have box stalls. Shavings not included and must be purchased through Brookside. You are

obligated to pay for the number of stalls you reserve. Stall reservations are required. One horse

per stall. Mares with foals may stall together.

Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to participate. AMHA Youth

Cards are \$20.00, \$25 if purchased at show and are good until December 31 of the year

the youth turns 18. An application may be filled out at the Show Office. **AMHA**

youth are those youth 18 years & under as of 1/1/2024.

An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur Classes.

Amateur cards are \$20.00 to AMHA members, \$25 if purchased at the show;

Amateur Classes: \$60.00 to non-members, \$65 if purchased at the show. Applications are

available at the Horse Show Office. Amateurs showing in Amateur/AOTE classes must be the owner of the horse or an immediate family member. **AOTE**

horses must not have been handled by a professional

Handler since December 31, 2023. No one with a professional trainer in the household

or on premises may compete in the AOTE division.

Stalls: Stall or Tack rooms are \$80.00/\$90.00 each -shavings not included. Shavings are

available through facility. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas only. Be sure to clean up after your horse at all times. No horse may be stabled in a horse trailer, or any other

vehicle/trailer used to haul at any NorCal show. One horse per stall.

Showing Out of

RV/Campers:

The Trailer: Showing out of the trailer is permitted at \$25.00 per horse per day.

Measuring will take place on Thursday from 4:00 - 8:00 p.m., Friday/Saturday 7:00am-Measuring: 7:30am. Hardship Measuring-Saturday-7-7:30 a.m. All horses without a permanent height

7:30am. Hardship Measuring-Saturday-7-7:30 a.m. All horses without a permanent height card must be measured. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement and payment is received. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at

measurement.

Office: Out-of-state horses may need Coggins & Health Cert to legally enter CA. Owners of

senior stallions (3 & older) must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for

cryptorchidism to show management prior to participating in an AMHA sanctioned show.

AMHA Judges Evaluation Cards are available in the Show Office.

All entry forms, color copies of both sides of the AMHA registration papers for each horse, lease agreements, copy of amateur and/or youth cards, copy of Veterinary Inspection for

Senior Stallions, and a check/credit card information/ money order for payment of classes, stalls, AMHA fee, RV fees, etc. are to be sent to Show Manager. Checks are to be made payable to: NORCAL Miniature Horse Club. Entries postmarked after the deadline of 05/09/2024 will incur an additional \$10 per horse late fee and \$5 per class late fee.

Any checks not honored by the bank will be charged a \$50.00 NSF fee. Incomplete entries or entries lacking payment are subject to \$10 office fee and \$5 Class late fee if not

corrected by entry deadline.

Refunds: Refunds will not be given without a veterinarian's written certificate stating why the

horse is unable to show. There will be no refunds on office fees.

Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

<u>PA System:</u>
It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to

the barn area are a management courtesy.

Pets:

All dogs must be leashed. Not allowed in food areas or seating areas.

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls,

or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.
