Spoke about UHEW Environment Day, which will be held June 9, 2023. Encourage Local
members and neighbours to clean parks and other locations with Local Executives. Kits will
be distributed prior to the event

## 5. PSAC REVP - Alex Silas

- Bargaining talk: The strike vote is continuing until April 11, and we will be back at the
  negotiation table with the employer on April 12 encouraged all members to take the strike
  training then register their vote; introduced our bargaining team (representing TC is Justin
  Cooke and representing PA is Samantha Basha)
- Some items we would like addressed at bargaining is remote/hybrid work model, as better language is needed in the agreement; another item is anti-racism training we are asking for mandatory training at all levels on work time, not our own time (this would be a huge step forward to end systemic racism in Canada)
- We can overwhelm the federal government; our goal is for a contract, not go on strike. But if we do, a general strike would have the biggest impact. We have 60 days to decide on strike action after the vote is complete it is not PSAC policy to announce numbers, but will announce if we have a strike mandate or not
- Question from floor: what happens if you are retiring shortly after a strike would happen? Would this affect your best years? Alex will get the correct answer
- Question from floor: EG parity case discussion are the rates locked in, as a solution was attained a year ago via arbitrator decision and is a major victory for PSAC and UHEW; this is not being addressed right now, as we do not have a current contract once bargaining is ended, there will be retro pay (not sure if it will be based on the old rate or the new one)

If the Secretary elected is not bilingual, then translation will be sought at the rate of \$0.12 / word.

Other requested Local documentation is to be completed by the Secretary or a translator as mentioned above.

The phrase "All other Local documents are available in English and French upon request." will be showcased on the Local website.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** <u>all</u> Monthly Executive Meeting Minutes and other monthly documents be removed from the Local website and archived on the Local Drive;

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** all mentions of the Translator Appointed Position be removed from the Local Bylaws.
