One of our congregation members asked if the Church Council would be willing to include a 'leader letter' in the monthly newsletter that helps to bring together, in one place, the current status of this wonderful Good Shepherd family - specifically, to summarize the 'stuff' that we discuss at the Town Hall meetings, since not everyone is able to attend those. Well, we <u>are</u> willing, so here goes.....

First, a word of PRAYER - that we all work to be the Hands and Feet of Jesus, spreading the Gospel and Christ's LOVE everywhere we go and in all we do! ~Amen.

The most common question asked at the Town Hall meetings is: "When are we going to get a new Pastor?" The fact of the matter is, we first must establish IF we can! Then we can discuss when. The hard, cold truth is that Good Shepherd simply cannot afford to pay a Pastor right now , and it would be fiscally irresponsible for us to try to do so. Our finances are running about 'even' each month supporting the expenses we have currently, which includes paying our 'supply' (fill-in) Pastors and our current staff members, but it cannot support the cost of a 'regular' Pastor (salary, benefits, housing, etc.). We are SO blessed to have the incredible talents of Kartika and Angie, along with a wonderful group of lay leaders!! In fact, worship attendance seems to have grown slightly, and the whole place is quite abuzz with energy, excitement, and support for each other as well as for our amazing organization! Still, we cannot afford to hire a Pastor right now.

Pastors are required in our denomination to fulfill some very specific church-related tasks (such as presiding over communion, for example). We have rostered Pastors available to help us with those tasks. Everything else can be done by lay people, and, luckily, we have lots of those willing to help, too! Yep, even guiding us in our faith journeys can be done by non-rostered Pastors.

We know that attendance and financial support at Good Shepherd has been declining, just like at SO many other churches across the <u>nation</u>, over the past several years (this is NOT a new problem) AND, we are not alone in being without a Pastor. Right here in our own community, several other ELCA Lutheran churches are also without a Pastor on staff. In fact, there are currently 1.5 Pastors and ten (10) ELCA churches in the area. Our Synod leaders are working alongside all of us to help us figure out what 'church' might look like here in the greater Wausau area into the future. What we know is this - it won't look like it did 50, 30, even 10 years ago! Times, they are a-changin'. And it's time for us to change with them.

So, what are we doing to right this ship? To find a way for Good Shepherd, and the people who call it their church home, to continue to worship, live, learn, and serve together?!

Lots of things! For starters, a number of meetings have occurred between leaders of the ELCA churches in the area to discuss where everyone is at right now - do they have a Pastor, how is their attendance, how engaged are their lay leaders, how strong are their finances, what's their building situation, how ready are they to hire a new Pastor, or partner/merge/close, and so on. It's important to know all of the players before we make decisions that could affect not only our own congregation, but others, as well. These conversations continue to evolve and dig deeper - it's a bit like a dating game, frankly. Not all of the proverbial cards are shown on the first date. Patience and persistence are the greatest skills in play right now.

Some of these same churches have already started coming together as a bigger "CHURCH" (not a formal worship building, but the church of believers as a whole): on July 16 worshiping at Rothschild Pavilion (with ~600 in attendance), and on September 10 to support some of our local 'unhomed' residents in downtown Wausau where nearly 40 people were gifted with a meal, toiletry packages, clothing, fellowship and love. These "shared ministry" opportunities will continue as we grow and learn more about and from our ELCA neighbors - the next is on **Sunday, October 8**, where we will swap worship leaders and musicians with Mount Calvary in Rothschild. Don't miss this exciting Sunday worship opportunity!

Once we know that we can reasonably afford to support a Pastor (part-time, full-time, shared with another congregation or two - there are lots of options!), **then** we will be ready for the more formal "call" process through which the Synod will guide us. This is a lengthy process - generally lasting for a year or more - though we have begun some of the preparatory work through a survey designed to help us define who we are and what special skills we want/need in our next Pastor.

So, what can YOU do to be a part of this process and our future success, you ask?!

- Continue to PRAY for our journey.
- Get INVOLVED there are so many ways....just ask if you're not sure.
- BRING friends/family to worship with you or invite them to view a video of our weekly worship service.
- BE Jesus' Hands & Feet, bringing love, light, and JOY wherever you go.
- Be OPEN to changes coming; the truth is that nothing is made to last forever. Adaptive organisms and organizations (and people, for that matter!) tend to last the longest. We most definitely want to see GSLC thrive into the future; it will take all of us working together toward this common goal to get there, though!

Please do not hesitate to reach out to a Council member or one of our office team members (Kartika or Angie) if you have questions, concerns, or better yet - IDEAS!

Thanks for your attention - we hope this 'Leader Letter' hits the mark and answers some common questions. We'll see you again soon!

- Mortgage and Snow Removal
 - Expenses used to be out of Building Fund. New boiler depleted the Building Fund, so mortgage and snow removal expenses were taken from General Fund to build up Building Fund again.
 - A proposal was made to move mortgage and snow removal back to Building Fund, as some people give specifically to the Building Fund for building related purposes such as mortgage and snow removal.
 Council discussed and decided to move back to taking Mortgage and Snow removal from the building fund as of Jan. 1, 2024. (MSC: Andy/Craig)
- 2024 Budget Review
 - Church Council discussed 1st draft of proposed budget for 2024 as prepared by the Finance Committee.

Newsletter

- Angie is leaving on vacation on Sept. 18th. If anyone has anything to get into the newsletter, please get it to Angie ASAP or before the 17th so she can get the newsletter out before she leaves.
- It was requested there would be a 'leader letter' in this month's newsletter and it was suggested that someone from council write it to provide updates on what is discussed at the town hall meetings, recent happenings at church, etc. A volunteer was asked for to write it and Jenn graciously volunteered.

Riverview School Safety Plan

- Riverview is looking for a place to go as part of their safety plan as both an inside and outside reunification place in the event of a fire, active shooter, etc.
- Laurie presented the info, and the Church Council discussed. A question was asked about our insurance and Laurie stated there is no issue with our insurance with this and the school's insurance would cover any child or school employee either inside or outside our building.
- Motion requested to allow Good Shepherd to be an inside and outside reunification place for Riverview School in the event of a need. (MSC: Cory/Jenn)

Portico

- Church Council discussed Angie and Kartika's insurance renewal comparing numbers with and without a salary increase and how that effects GSLC's 2024 budget
- Chad made a motion to increase the salary of Angie and Kartika 5% as well as an increase in HSA contributions from \$600 to \$900 annually. Motion will be carried forward as part of the 2024 budget which still needs to be approved. (MSC: Chad/Laurie)

Council Replacements

- These members will have fulfilled their council commitment in Jan. 2024: Jenny Samperisi, Cory Toth-LaPointe.
- Term 1 will be complete for Shelly Ellenbecker, Cheryl Rocheleau, and Tony Omernik in Jan. 2024, and they will have the choice to continue on council or be done.
- We do have an immediate open position for anyone that may be interested. Please contact any council member or Angie if interested.

Composting Opportunity

- Hsu's currently composts food waste and paper towel. They requested putting a bin here at GSLC and charge us \$5/mo.
- The council discussed and decided not to move forward with it


