To be most noted is our committee who support animal rescue & management. Lacey Township has a unique animal rescue/ management facility known as The Popcorn Park Zoo. Opened in the 1970's it is an oasis for abandoned animals from lions, monkeys and bears to dogs and cats (ahscares.org Associated Humane Societies / communities shelters.)
