FREQUENCY OF USE











MODE OF TRANSPORTATION

There is a big difference of who is AT the pool and who is IN the pool. More sun worshipers than swimmers and many hours with no one and again for only 1/4 of the year.

We don't use the pool much because of the number of people there are, and the small size of the pool/seating area.

We don't mind the expansion of the pool, but don't want to pay any more in dues per month. We don't feel that we get anything for our \$1,200 per year right now.

Also, with unlimited invites to quests to the pool this year, there are way too many people at the pool during times that we would typically go.

We have walked up to the pool a couple of times and there are 3-4 times the number of kids as adults.

It is overcrowded, noisy, and difficult for adults who want to swim quietly. Times that were set aside for adults in the past....early morning or mid afternoon.

HOA has grown exponentially but the pool size is the same, much too small for the population. The occupancy often exceeds state safety regulations for public pools.

Perhaps a discussion is needed about building another pool for the Sunrise area....perhaps charging an annual membership fee to anyone who wants to use either pool.
