#### Why a Community Baby Shower?

Memphis has the highest infant mortality rate among the nation's 60 largest cities. Babies deaths in Memphis are double that of the average rate of the national. **An infant dies in Shelby County every 43 hours.** 

In 2002, 202 babies didn't see their first birthday. Think about that. That is enough babies to fill 10 kindergarten classrooms. By comparison, there were 122 homicide victims in the city and county last year. Several

Memphis ZIP codes have infant death rates higher than scores of Third World countries. North Memphis' 38108, which include the tattered communities of Douglass and Hollywood, are deadlier for babies than Vietnam, El Salvador and Iran. Infant mortality is the barometer of a community's problems:

- poverty,
- pollution,
- crime,
- lack of education,
- access to health care and
- safe, affordable housing.

Although, Black mothers nationwide are more than twice as likely to lose a child before age 1 than other women, Fresh Starts Community Baby Shower targets all races and backgrounds in the City of Memphis that are at risk of losing children prematurely. Memphis' infant death rate is higher than New York City and Dallas combined.



Credit to Fresh Starts Community baby Shower and other worthy initiatives, the issue is on the radar of local political and community leaders. In Memphis, the nation's infant death capital for at least a decade, efforts to confront these problems have been increased but are splintered. Only recently has there has been a comprehensive effort to curb the problem. However, programs have come and gone as funding has come and gone. FSCBS has been a constant in the fight to lower infant mortality.

More than 60 percent of city high school students say they've had sex and nearly a third have had four or more partners. Shelby County's teen pregnancy rate is down but still among the country's highest. Prematurity is the No. 1 baby killer in Memphis and nationwide, accounting for at least 60 percent of the deaths. In half of those cases doctors don't know why the babies came early. Poor women are more likely to deliver too early - between 20 and 37 weeks - and lose their babies. The odds are against them. Their lives too often reflect the long list of risk factors.

#### Underprivileged mothers are less likely to get prenatal care, less likely to eat right and get vitamins they need.

This group is more likely to smoke, drink, use drugs, and suffer mental and physical abuse. They're more likely to have unplanned or back-to-back pregnancies. These mothers are more often high school dropouts and teenagers, more likely to live near toxic streams and dumping grounds.

The county's eleven public health clinics nestled in the poorest neighborhoods see thousands of patients - many of them teens with their moms - seeking birth control and other ob-gyn services each year. Thousands more are on Medicaid using private providers. But last year 604 mothers got no prenatal care. Hundreds more saw the doctor too little or too late. At least one-third of the pregnant teens got inadequate care.

The message is clear that there is a need for an event of this nature. We would be pleased to have you join us in this year's Community Baby Shower. You will find that there is no other event in the city that delivers a unique mix of support, awareness, education, and opportunity - in a celebration of **motherhood**, **health**, and **life**.
