My name is Bryce Matthew Cuellar, I'm 25 years old, born on November 13, 1991 in Las Vegas, NV. I'm writing from prison, and have 12 months served on a 4 year sentence over a youtube video. I was charged with "attempt making threats or conveying false information concerning acts of terrorism". I believe my video was unprofessional, and bad Christian conduct, but I don't believe I should be in prison over it. The Bible says to "be sober, be vigilant, because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" - 1 Peter 5:8 I was intoxicated in the video, and wearing my body armor, and holding my guns. I expressed my frustration towards the fact that this is not the America our founding fathers gave us, and how traitors in government are taking our freedoms. I said, in the video, that I would use my 2nd amendment to kill traitors in government during nation wide martial law in the event of unconstitutional gun confiscation. I labeled some of these traitors as homosexuals, illuminati freemasons, and satanist working in government to use their positions of authority to infiltrate, and undermine We The People. My video gave the enemy an opportunity to do what they were seeking to do for a long time... put me in prison. The code of conduct for the Christian soldier is not to stop us from having fun. It's here for our protection. God allowed the enemy to use this opportunity to persecute me for many reasons. One reason is "Blessed is the man who thou chastenest, O LORD" - Psalm 93:12

I would include how Moses murdered an Egyptian tyrant, but Acts 7:24 (1611 KJV) says Moses was defending the oppressed, and justifies Moses, and I look forward to discussing this in a different letter about biblical permission to use force to defend the oppressed. Moses did the right thing. Back to my main point. Men of God have a less than perfect track record, and God did not hide their downfalls from the world. I'm no different and being a young man, I'm still being built up into the man God wants me to be. Either way I'll never be sinless "For a just man falleth seven times, and riseth up again" - Proverbs 24:16, A soldier of God who breaks protocol during a heated spiritual war gives opportunity to Satan to attack, but I will survive the attack, and rise back up. I hate to use this ~~metaphor~~ <sup>analogy</sup>, but this is a great parable. A Christian's walk, and spiritual life is like a video game. As you progress through the stages you gain experience, knowledge, and understanding ~~of~~ <sup>of</sup> how it works. With each level comes more, and more challenges, obstacles, and difficulties to overcome with your weapons of war, and you have less, and less room for mistakes, and bad choices, because the stakes are much higher, and one wrong move is all the enemy needs to take all you have, even your life!

As you progress through the levels, your enemies get bigger, stronger, more elaborate, and attack more frequently with various weapons. The enemies strength is what makes us stronger. As our enemies get big, we get bigger. As they get strong, we get stronger. Like a weight lifter, the only way to get bigger, and stronger is to increase the resistance we face to coincide with our growth. An elite, veteran Christian Soldier will almost always come up against government opposition. To name a few, there's Jesus Christ, Elijah, Moses, Joseph, David, Jeremiah, John the baptist, the apostle Paul, Daniel, Dr. Kent Hovind, and myself. Results from government persecution varies, but includes torture, death, and/or imprisonment. The spiritual war takes Gods effective soldiers through the levels of trials up to the final level, or the "main enemy boss" in our video game analogy. This is because Satan, in most cases, controls the worlds governments. For proof, read Daniel 10, Ezekiel 28, and Matthew 4:8. I consider myself to be a prisoner of war. When I enlisted to be a soldier in Gods military, I knew the dangers, and I knew that my training would be difficult. I signed up with my eyes on the prize, knowing that the benefits offered far outweighed the risks involved. Any investment worth making requires you to give what you have as an investment, and to wait patiently for a seven fold return. To reap a harvest you have to first sow the seeds you have. Hence, Jesus said to get your life you have to lose it. When you sow your life as a seed, the seed dies before it produces a harvest. Jesus said take up your cross, and follow Him. Many Christians in America have been deceived.

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Pastors in America want to keep money flowing into the collection plate so they can buy a more expensive sound & light system in order to impress the single parents, the widows, the sick, and the fatherless who need that money. The pastors preach watered down, sugar coated, financial ~~prosperity~~ <sup>prosperity</sup> sermons, and avoid sermons that might offend people. Anything that might cause shame, embarrassment, and an uncomfortable atmosphere that might offend people and scare away people who came to hear what they want to hear, and not what they need to hear, the pastors avoid. The church has lost its saltiness. Jesus said we are the salt of the earth, a light on a hill! Today's church in America is a light that is hid under a basket.

"Now we command you brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every (christian) brother that walks disorderly" - 2 Thessalonians 3:6, This is why I don't go to Church. Today's Christian soldiers in America signed up only for the benefits and have gone AWOL from the battle field expecting to still receive the benefits of eternal salvation. They, and their pastors have been deceived. They have not fulfilled their end of the contract. Giving your life to Christ means just that. I'm going to tell you what most pastors won't tell you, because they only want to "make merchandise of you" - 2 Peter 2:3. Being salt, and telling you the truth would cost a pastor income, and he might not be able to afford the iPhone 8 to use for snapshots of the new theater quality seats he bought for the poor people in his congregation to sit in for one hour a week. Here's the truth about being a Christian.

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In Matthew 25:14 Jesus Christ gives a metaphor/parable of the kingdom of heaven. In the parable there are two types of servants. There's the profitable servant, and the unprofitable servant. The profitable servant uses the talents given to him to work for his master, but the unprofitable servant takes his talent, hides it, and does nothing. The unprofitable servant goes to hell, and he represents an unproductive Christian, the five foolish with no oil in their lamps at the rapture, the person who hides their light under a basket, and has become salt that is not salty, and worships God with their mouth although their hearts are far from Him. A profitable servant, a REAL soldier for Christ, an effective soul winner will be marked by this ~~his~~ following description, and code of conduct. A soldier of Christ enlists not just for the benefits, and not just for the health & life insurance policy, but to join the fight in the war against evil. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son" - John 3:16 "We ought to lay down our lives for the brethren" - 1 John 3:16 "For I (Jesus) have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done" - John 13:15 "Will you lay down your life for my sake?" - John 13:38 "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends" - John 15:13. I already know what you're thinking so let me stop you right there by saying this "There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. He that fears is not made perfect in love" - 1 John 4:18. "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of sound mind" - 2 Timothy 1:7

Now I will continue. "He that loves his life shall lose it, and he that hates his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. If any man serve me, let him follow me" - John 12:25-26. "What is a man profited if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his soul?" - MATH 16:26

"I write to you these things to warn you" - 1 Corinthians 4:14.

Here's the warning for those looking for eternal life. "All that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" - 2 Timothy 3:12.

"Think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you as though some strange thing happened to you" - 1 Peter 4:12. We must through much tribulation enter into the Kingdom of God - Acts 14:22.

"Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the pleasure of sin for a season" - Hebrews 11:25. "If we suffer, we shall also reign with Him (Jesus)" - 2 Timothy 2:12.

For thy sake we are killed all the day long" - Romans 8:36.

"For me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain" - Philippians 1:21.

"Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground, and die, it abideth alone, but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit" - John 12:24.

So you see, to give your life to Christ means to be willing to lose everything you have, even your freedom, family, and life. "Some of you shall they cause to be put to death, and ye shall be hated of all men for my names sake" - Luke 21:17-18.

"Be not afraid of them that kill the body,.... I forewarn you whom ye shall fear.... fear Him that hath power to cast into hell" - Luke

4-5. Most people are afraid to lose their material possessions. What they own, in reality owns them. Jesus Christ owned nothing but the clothes on His back. A soldier on the battlefield needs to travel light, carrying only the necessities, and in war, a soldier isn't thinking about his T.V. at home, or his car, or his iPhone. He's focused on his objective. A soldier under enemy fire thinks about where he's going when he dies, and not about how he left the oven on at home.

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"Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth (makes war) entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please Him who hath chosen him to be a soldier" - 2 Timothy 2:3-4. "I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ" - Philippians 3:8. An effective soldier of Christ is "troubled on every side, yet not distressed, we are perplexed, but not in despair, persecuted, but not forsaken, cast down, but not destroyed" - 2 Corinthians 4:8-9. A soldier has to leave his family, his home, his possessions, and his old self behind to be stationed where his commanding officer wants him, and the commanding officer gives him what he needs to do the job he was trained for. Now I understand there are many Christians whom God gave callings to that don't demand such sacrifices, but any Christian living in the will of God will face some very hard trials nonetheless. No Christian is exempt. Some soldiers have less hazardous jobs, but only because someone has to do that job. They will still be tested. A soldier survives by following, and obeying the word. "Be doers of the word, not hearers only" - James 1:22. A soldier who doesn't put into practice his training during war is a soldier who forgot his gun, ammo, and body armor. To a Christian soldier, our weapon, body armor, and battle field ~~training~~ training is composed of the Bible, and putting the Bible into practice. I'll come back to this. A good soldier conforms to the word of God. "Be not conformed to this world" - Romans 12:2

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A good Soldier is free from any emotional ties to this world, and cares only about the Lords business. "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him" - 1 John 2:15. Most of the major characters in the Bible experienced either imprisonment, separation from their family, government/public persecution, exile, the loss of everything they had, and much suffering. These things, in many cases, ended with great reward, and blessing. It's the law of sowing before reaping. A soldier who makes it through the hell of war is honorably discharged as a highly decorated, well paid, generously blessed man of God. All Christians must fight through the valley of the shadow of death, and some have to die in the fight. Jesus said to whom much is given, much is expected. Most people who were given the blood of Jesus Christ as payment for their sins, and their crimes, don't in the least bit grasp how much they were given, and the Bible is used to condone sin, and justify their lifestyle. God accepts you as you are as in any sinner can be saved no matter where he's at in life, but a gradual transformation in your life takes place. We're suppose to deny ourself, take up our daily cross, and crucify our flesh. I'll explain more in a different letter. Anyone who wants to serve God must be prepared to lose ~~●~~ anything, and everything you have. Satan will take you for all ~~✓~~ you've got. In war, things can get nasty. Satan will do everything he can to turn you against God.

"Fear none of those things thou shalt suffer... be faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life" - Revelations 2:10 In the book of Ephesians Chapter 6, verse 12, it tells you the nature of the enemy. Our enemy is spiritual and inter dimensional. Our weapons, and armor are also spiritual. The helmet of salvation, breast plate of righteousness, shield of faith, the sword of the spirit which is the word (Bible), the belt of truth, and the shoes of the gospel of peace. If one of those is missing, you're gonna have a bad time! I want to talk about the church in America now. Satan has been successful in dividing the church of God, the body of Christ, into ~~church~~ denominations, and sects. Do we not all have the same Holy Spirit, and believe that Jesus Christ is Lord, and is the only mediator between us, and God? Jesus was against the creation of denominations, and so were the apostles because it divided the body of Christ. Jesus said a house divided against its self can not stand. Satans NWO motto is "divide, and conquer." A divided military cannot organize a concentrated attack on the enemy. When the CIA topples a nation, they simply create division, and they get the people of ~~that~~ that nation ~~to~~ to destroy themselves through internal civil war. The last "Christian" church I went to for two weeks had a homosexual on the praise, and worship team. This is satanic, and sends the wrong message. Politically correct, gender equality, and so called "non judgmental" churches have become nothing more than a social forum where people come just to be seen by other people, hoping that someone will notice their expensive outfit. It was a main stream corporate semi-mega church. As a rule of thumb, the bigger the church, the faker it is. It's a place where the blind lead the blind. Jesus had disciples, and John the baptist had disciples, but they never had a regular congregation. They were learning as they went. This is called "on the job training."

America has become godless, immoral, and vulgar because the Church in America has forgotten her duties. Pastors have become watchman that are leading the sheep astray. To the Church leaders in America, Jesus says "He that is greatest among you shall be your servant, and whosoever exalts himself shall be abased (humiliated), and he that humble himself shall be exalted" - Matthew 23:12. Darkness cannot over power light, yet darkness is taking over America because the body of Christ is not taking her light to the darkness like Jesus did. A great persecution of the church is coming to America, and it will separate the real soldiers who signed up to fight from the fake, lukewarm "soldiers" who only enlisted for the benefits offered. America needs persecution to awaken the sleeping body of Christ, and unite all the divided Churches. When Christians are being murdered, and imprisoned in America, it will no longer matter if you're a 7<sup>th</sup> day adventist, or babbtist, or any denomination. The enemy won't care what denomination you are. All who profess to believe in Jesus Christ will be persecuted. In 1606, and in 1609 The first charter of Virginia stated that "the purpose of the James Town colony was for propagating of Christian religion to such people, as yet live in darkness, to preach and baptize into the Christian religion, and recover sinners out of the arms of the devil." More on this in a different letter, but it looks to me like America has reversed her course, and forgotten her principles.
