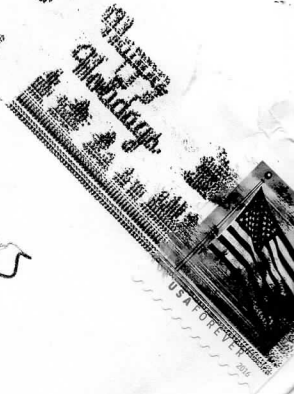


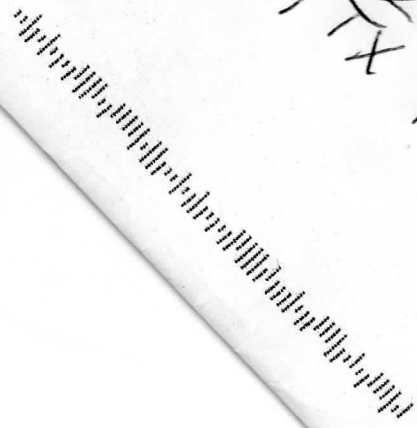

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① "The Holy Trinity Explained 2018"

Here is a topic no one has ever been able to explain to me in a way I could comprehend and make sense of. I was always given the same answer, and told the Trinity is "the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The three are one, but separate entities." When I asked how that was possible or why it was that God is 3 different entities or how God could have a Son yet the Son be One with God, no one could answer because they themselves didn't completely understand it either. To save face they would tell the 10 year old me "it's hard to explain." They can only regurgitate a description of the Holy Trinity. I can give you a description of a car engine but I can't tell you how it works because I never studied the engine instruction manual. Albert Einstein said "If you can't explain it simply, you don't understand it well enough." I will attempt to explain it simply using scriptures I studied, and compiled. I will also give some metaphors and some analogies. If by the end of this letter you still don't understand the Holy Trinity, then you are spiritually blind, and God has denied you spiritual understanding which is required because you are still carnally minded. I have scriptures to back that up and will make that the topic of my next letter. Pray for divine revelation. There are 13 mysteries mentioned in the new testament all of which are spiritually understood only. One of these mysteries is "the mystery of God, of the Father, and of Christ (the Trinity)" Colossians 2:2. "They are spiritually discerned" - 1 Corinthians 2:14. "God hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit" - 1 Corinthians 2:10. "Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the Kingdom of heaven" - Matthew 13:11 →

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"For no man understandeth Him, howbeit in the Spirit He speaketh mysteries" - 1 Corinthians 13:2 "The secret of the LORD is with them that fear Him" - Psalms 25:14. We are "Stewards of the mysteries of God" - 1 Corinthians 4:1. More on this in my next letter, but my point is knowing Scripture is not the same as understanding Scripture. A common complaint I hear is how hard it is to understand what the Bible is saying. I had that problem years ago and continuously prayed for God to help me understand the scriptures. "Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures" - Luke 24:45. Jesus Christ said He spoke in parables because the people lacked the capacity to understand spiritual matters. Even then many people didn't even understand His parables. Carnally minded Christians as mentioned in 1 Corinthians 2:1-16 & 3:1-4 don't understand the deeper spiritual side of the Bible. The Bible has much to say about the Holy Trinity if only people took the time to read, search through, and study the scriptures. It took me coming to prison to put serious time into the Holy Scriptures, but it was well worth the price. And now, here's an honest, Biblical perspective of the Holy Trinity. I doubt you'll find a better lesson on this topic. I'll start with the basics. As many of us know, the Trinity, (God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit) are three but one. These 3 make up the LORD. I want to point out that in the old testament the LORD was spelled with all capital letters. This was before the word was made flesh, before Jesus Christ was born. In the new testament the Lord is not spelled with all capital letters. God was not always split into three entities. He, the LORD, was "All in All" which Zechariah 14:9, and 1 Corinthians 15:28 ~~talks~~ talks about, and it will happen again, but not until after the 1,000 year reign with Christ on earth.

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"In the beginning was the word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God" - John 1:1. Before Jesus was "begotten", the LORD was ALL IN ALL until "the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us" - John 1:14 which is why the Lord is not spelled with all capital letters in the new testament. The LORD is now operating in two bodies, not one. True, the Angel of the LORD is the pre-incarnate Jesus Christ that Moses, and Abraham spoke directly to, but He was not yet made flesh. He was still 100% a spirit. The Holy Trinity, also called the Godhead consists of one mind i.e. Gods Consciousness, and two separate bodies, one natural/physical body, and one spiritual. "There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body" - 1 Corinthians 15:44. There is the Mind, Body, and (Holy) Spirit. The mind is also called the soul. On a quick side note, humans are also a trinity. "I pray... your whole spirit, and soul, and body..." - 1 Thessalonians 5:23. That passage is saying we have a spirit and a body, not just a fleshly body, and a soul which is our consciousness. "Glorify God in your body, and in your spirit which are Gods" - 1 Corinthians 6:20. The human trinity is for a different letter. The Holy Spirit was operating on earth through the vessel of a human. When people spoke to Jesus Christ they were speaking directly to the Holy Ghost which is God. "God is a spirit" - John 4:24 who was operating "through the veil, that is to say, His flesh" - Hebrews 10:20 which is why "Christ Jesus the Lord" "is that Spirit" - 2 Corinthians 4:5, 3:17. This is why Jesus Christ said "I and My Father are One" - John 10:30. And "Jesus said... before Abraham was, I AM" - John 8:58. "...he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father... I am in the Father, and the Father in Me... the Father dwelleth in Me" - John 14:9-11. Consider these two scriptures. "Whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My name, He may give it you" - John 15:16 & "If ye shall ask anything in My name, that will I do..." - John 14:14. Jesus Christ and the Father are interchangeable because they're the same Person.

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All throughout the new testament the names of God are all used interchangeably. Examples are "God our Father, God and Father, God the Father, Lord God, Lord Jesus Christ". The Father is God, God is the Lord, and the Lord is Jesus Christ. Keep in mind that God is the Holy Spirit, a Spiritual body controlled by the mind of the Father. God our Father is the Lord Jesus Christ because God ~~our~~ the Father was, and is inside Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ doesn't have a separate mind of His own. There isn't two minds in one body like you would have in a case of demon possession where you have the persons mind plus the demons mind inside one body. Jesus Christ only had one mind and it was the mind of the heavenly Father who was on earth inside Jesus Christ and in heaven on His throne simultaneously, at the exact same time. Jesus Christ claimed He was on earth and in heaven in John 3:13 when He said "No man hath ascended up to heaven, but He that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven." Jesus Christ says again that He is the Holy Spirit, "The spirit of truth whom the world cannot receive dwelleth in you and shall be in you... I will come to you... you shall know that I am in My Father, and ye in Me, and I in you" - John 14:17-20. "I will not leave you comfortless, I will come to you" - John 14:18. "The Spirit of God dwelleth in you" - Romans 8:9. "Christ liveth in me" - Galatians 2:20. Which is why the Bible says that we have the mind of Christ. We literally have a second mind/soul inside of us, the mind of God Himself, and many times God works through us without us ever realizing that what we're doing or saying is God in us speaking, and working through us. "He that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit" - 1 Corinthians 6:17. Some might ask "how can God be in heaven and on earth in different bodies at the same time"? First off, God has no limitations, He's incapable of being incapable.

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True, God cannot sin for the same reason light cannot be darkness, but that's not a handicap or limitation of power. Here are ~~4~~ scriptures showing how God is everywhere at the same time. "The LORD looketh from heaven, ... from the place of His habitation He looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth" - Psalms 33:13-14. "Let the whole earth be filled with His glory" - Psalms 72:19. "For He hath looked down from the height of His sanctuary, from heaven did the LORD behold the earth" - Psalms 102:19. "Do not I fill heaven, and earth? Saith the LORD" - Jeremiah 23:24. There you have it. God is in heaven, and on earth at the same time, and people who have God are possessed by the Holy Spirit. "Now the Lord (Jesus Christ) is that Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty" - 2 Corinthians 3:17. People who don't have the Spirit of LIBERTY have the spirit of bondage which are demons or "the spirit of the anti-christ." They are enslaved by sin, and death. This gets into why God never condemns slavery in the Bible. Our great, great grandfather Adam sold himself and all his offspring (which is us) into a system of slavery when he sinned. God had to purchase us to redeem us from bondage which He could not have done if He condemned the very system He had to go through in order to buy our freedom. That's a different letter I already have scriptures compiled for, but is why (in a nutshell) He doesn't condemn slavery. God revealed that to me after years of wondering why He allowed slavery. It's not that He allowed it. It's part of the curse of sin, and slavery will remain in this fallen world until God renews everything. Anyways, "Ye are the temple of the living God... God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them" - 2 Corinthians 6:16. God now operates through millions of saved believers throughout the world and ~~we~~ we are all connected into the "Holy Spirit Network" which is called the body of Christ.

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God is big enough to give every saved believer His complete undivided attention at the exact same time. He is everywhere and upholds everything. I'll end this letter with a recap. The Father is Gods mind/soul, the Holy Spirit is Gods spiritual body, and Jesus Christ is Gods natural/physical body. God ~~has~~ has one mind, and two bodies, same as us. I decided not to give a metaphor as it was not adequate. That's it for this letter.
