V. SPECIFIC EVIDENCE RELIED ON TO SUPPORT FINDINGS (Physical evidence, observations, written documents, etc.):

During this discipline hearing, the following information was evidentiary and documented by the DHO in his findings.

GERHARD's involvement in the incident, as noted in Section 11 of Incident Report 3113949, as provided by A. Cheung, Lieutenant, was reviewed. Paraphrased, Cheung writes: On April 17, 2018, at approximately 11:00 pm, as the Operations Lieutenant, I received a phone call from Officer Irving stating that he found a plastic bag full of government invoices from the Food Service department of USP Allenwood sitting on top of the inmate's mailbox. After review of the unit surveillance video, I observed inmate GERHARD, Jason #20229-045 walk across the common area of Unit Union-B with a plastic bag full of papers in his right hand at approximately 10:13 pm according to video timestamp. Inmate GERHARD proceeded to place that bag full of papers on top of the inmate's mailbox located in the unit and walked away. At approximately 10:26 pm, Officer Irving is seen on video making rounds of the unit and walks up to the inmate's mailbox and retrieved the same plastic bag full of papers from the top of the inmate's mailbox which inmate GERHARD left behind. After questioning inmate GERHARD, he proceeded to tell me that the copies of all the Food Services invoices were obtained through a FOIA request. Inmate GERHARD told me he did not personally submit the FOIA request. Inmate GERHARD said another inmate submitted the FOIA request but is no longer assigned to LSCI Allenwood. Inmate GERHARD said he took the invoices from that unidentified inmate before he left this institution. Inmate GERHARD decided to leave all of the invoices on top of the inmate's mailbox because he did not have any use for them at this time.

Inculpatory evidence in the form of video surveillance photo clips showing Gerhard within union B unit, while holding a plastic bag full of documents were reviewed. Photocopies of various Allenwood complex food service packing slip in order documents were reviewed. A memorandum from R. Irving, declared he was personally responsible for discovering a clear bag full of food service invoices on the mailbox in union B. A "flikshop" postcard showed a picture of an individual and stated, "I did get the fresh food invoices from the FOIA request so I will send those out this week."

Upon questioning by the DHO, GERHARD denied the charges. He elaborated upon his plea by stating, "Yeah, I had the papers. They were in my possession. No, I did not steal them. It was an FOIA request from another guy." While the DHO found no information to reveal Gerhard responsible for stealing the food service order documents as noted in Lieut. Cheung's incident report, he was clearly observed in possession of the same on April 17, 2018, at 11 PM, within union B as documented. Gerhard's testimony, coupled with the "flikshop" document, convinced the DHO the discovered food service documents were not Gerhard personal possession. With this, the DHO supported the code 305 infraction.

After the consideration of evidence documented above, the DHO has drawn the conclusion the greater weight of the evidence, listed in the paragraphs above, supports the finding, GERHARD, Register No. _____

GERHARD's possession of unauthorized items threatened the orderly running of LSCI Allenwood. For inmates to retain items not provided to them through institutional channels indicates defiance and refusal to follow established and known policy. Limits are placed on inmate property to persuade them not to possess unnecessary items. Accordingly, loss of e-mail and visitation privileges are sanctioned in an effort to punish GERHARD for his behavior, while hopefully deterring him from it in the future.

VIII. APPEAL RIGHTS: X The inmate has been advised of the findings, specific evidence relied on action and reasons for the action. The inmate has been advised of the right to appeal this action within 20 calendar days under the Administrative Remedy Procedure. A copy of this report has been given to the inmate.

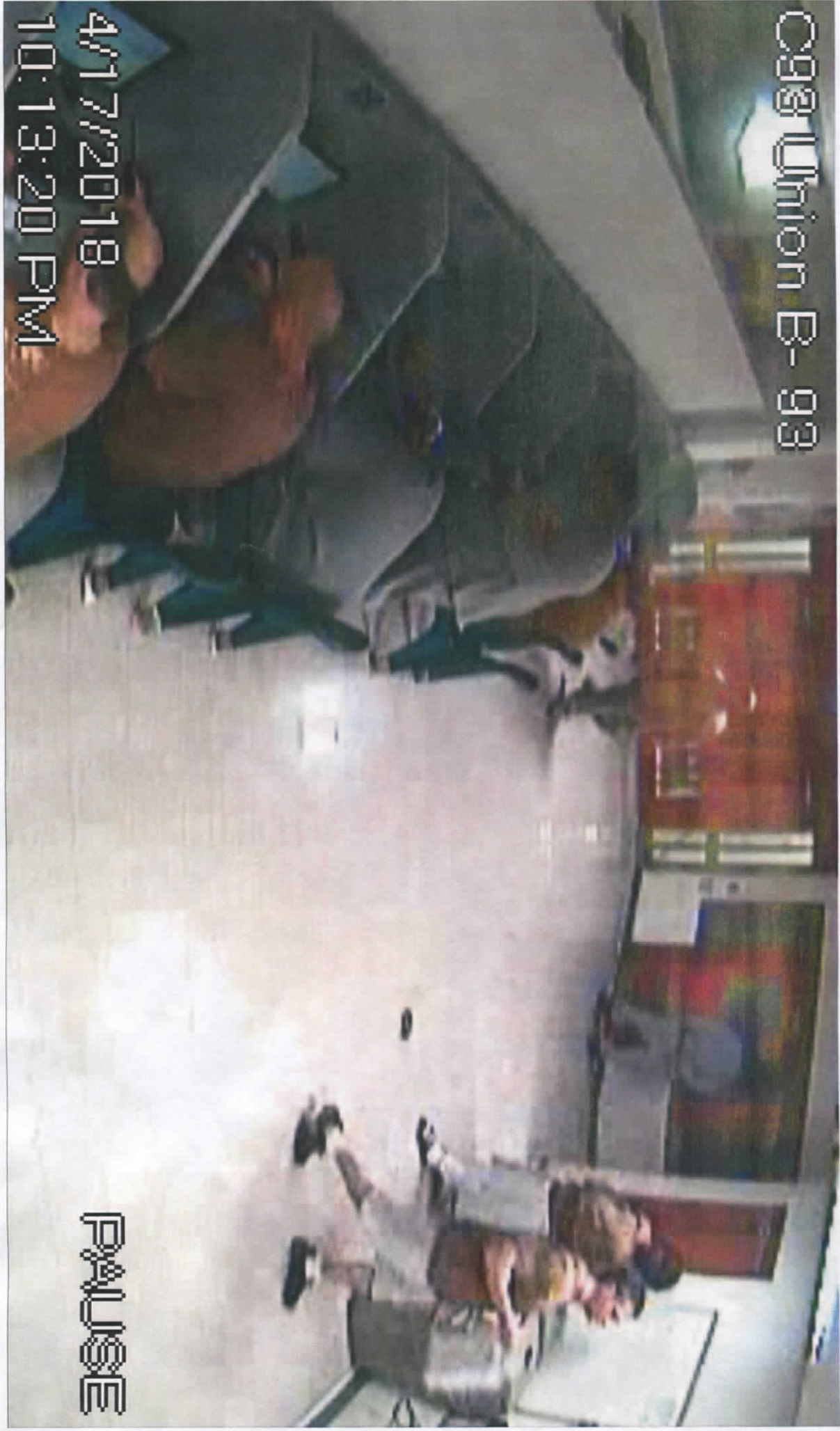

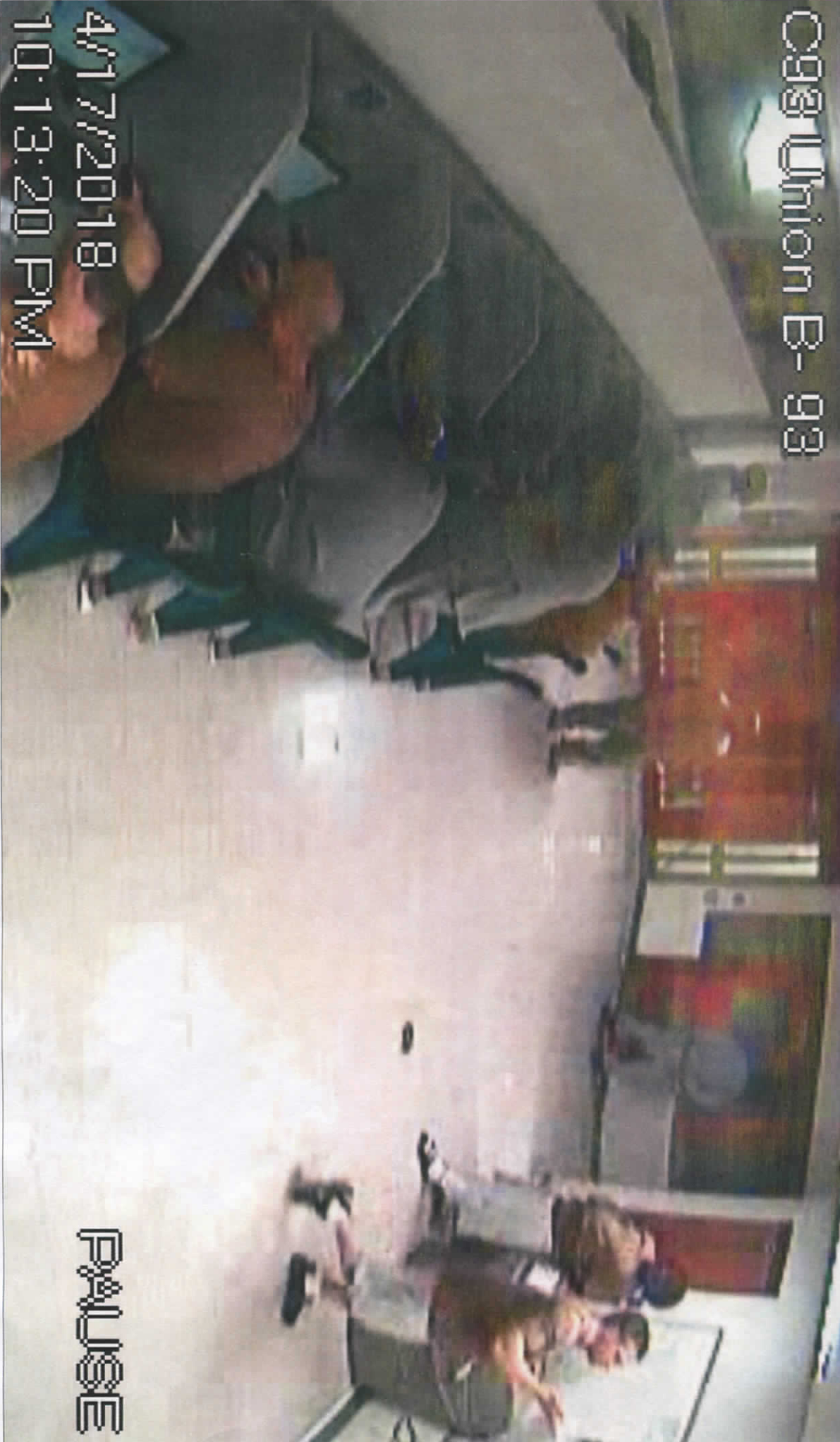

As an inmate charged with a violation of Bureau of Prisons rules or regulations referred to the Discipline Hearing Officer (DHO) for disposition, you have the following rights:

1. The right to have a written copy of the charge(s) against you at least 24 hours prior to appearing before the Discipline Hearing Officer;
2. The right to have a full-time member of the staff who is reasonably available to represent you before the Discipline Hearing Officer;
3. The right to call witnesses (or present written statements of unavailable witnesses) and to present documentary evidence in your behalf, provided institutional safety would not be jeopardized;
4. The right to present a statement or to remain silent. Your silence may be used to draw an adverse inference against you. However, your silence alone may not be used to support a finding that you committed a prohibited act;
5. The right to be present throughout the discipline hearing except during a period of deliberation or when institutional safety would be jeopardized. If you elect not to appear before the DHO, you may still have witnesses and a staff representative appear on your behalf;
6. The right to be advised of the DHO's decision, the facts supporting that decision, except where institutional safety would be jeopardized, and the DHO's disposition in writing; and,
7. The right to appeal the decision of the DHO by means of the Administrative Remedy Procedure to the Regional Director within 20 calendar days of notice of the DHO's decision and disposition.


