Re: Chilcotin Ambassador, ACJ Michael W. Parsons

PLEASE BE ADVISED that the State of the Chilcotin via the Chilcotin National Congress (validated recently on March 26, 2018 by PM J. Trudeau's exoneration of ancestors), has filed an Application with the International Court of Justice against all judges involved in the kidnapping and illegal detention of Ambassador Parsons.

In order to avoid further violations of international law such as the *Montevideo Convention on the Rights and Duties of State*, the *Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations*, as well as the Universal Supreme Court order (Universal Supreme Court orders never challenged or found invalid) attached hereto, the Chilcotin National Congress requests the immediate release of Ambassador Parsons on his own recognizance.

Letter to Governor Ricketts dated August 17, 2018 is also hereto attached for your information.

Also, for your information, 2nd copy of Ambassador Parsons's Diplomatic Visa application is obtainable from Division E, Major Crimes Unit RCMP detachment [contact info provided below] which is prima facie evidence of Ambassador Parsons's diplomatic status still awaiting an approval or denial from the President.
