NOTICE OF INQUIRY AND MOTION FOR ORDER

Petitioner received notification that his case was transferred to the Southern District to be litigated. Previously petitioner requested a copy of all the documents he filed because Okeechobee prevents the copying of legal documents to inmates like petitioner which obstructs and hinders petitioner's ability to have his own copy and mail copies to all defendants as required by law. Petitioner now has to send documents to a friend via email in order to ensure that the court receives them because since last month of June, a mailroom clerk has refused to send out my legal mail which is a federal offense.

RELIEF SOUGHT

Petitioner is seeking the following relief:

1. Issue an Order instructing the clerk to mail petitioner copies of all motions he has filed thus far.
2. Issue an Order directing the mailroom clerk C. Tharp to deliver all legal mail and regular mail and open all legal mail in the presence of petitioner.
3. Issue an Order to the mailroom to provide all the mail they say they returned to sender and have not.
4. Issue an order to the Department of Corrections to stop preventing the sending of legal content via email as they have repeatedly done and just rejected an email with legal content erroneously stating it violates DOC policy. See Exhibit 1
