At approximately 10:30 p.m. Inmate Carter was approached by a male officer when he was on the toilet and asked him was he ok and he responded, "I'm on the toilet". The male officer then walked off. Inmate Carter upon exiting restroom asked officer D. Smith did she think he was gunning her or something and she responded that she wanted to check why he was on the toilet so long, and got an attitude with inmate Carter and started using profanity. It is against administrative policy 33.208 for officers to use profanity when addressing inmates. Also it is quite disturbing that a female officer is watching inmates while they are on the toilet. If the roles were reversed with a male officer and female inmate this would be a PREA issue. Inmates shouldn't be exposed to the point to where officers can visibly watch them use the toilet, especially females.

It is apparent that your officers feel that the law, rules and regulations don't apply to them because they constantly use profanity, engage in behavior that will inevitably provoke an inmate to retaliate with violence. Your officers are creating a hostile environment without any justification and will soon escalate to a situation that could be fatal and could be avoided if your officers would conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times. I feel that it is expedient that you speak with officer D. Smith and your other officers who have this misnomer that they can curse out inmates, talk disrespectful and there won't be no consequences and repercussions.

I am also requesting the personnel file for officer D. Smith under the Freedom of Information Request and pursuant to Rule 33.102.16 Public Information and Inspection of Records.

Thanks in advance for your cooperation and consideration in this most exigent matter.
