Count 1:

S. Dev Dley on or about August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia, heard denial of defence of jurisdiction against internationally protected persons Zsuzsanna Holland, willfully and unlawfully, committed the indictable offence of Obstructing justice, contrary to Section 139 (3) of the Criminal Code.

Count 2:

S. Dev Dley on or about August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia, heard denial of defence of jurisdiction against internationally protected persons Zsuzsanna Holland, willfully and unlawfully, committed the indictable offence of Obstructing justice, contrary to Section 139 (2) of the Criminal Code.

Count 3:

S. Dev Dley on or about December 11, 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia, denied internationally protected persons Zsuzsanna Holland, defence of jurisdiction, willfully and unlawfully, committed the indictable offence of Obstructing justice, contrary to Section 139 (3) of the Criminal Code.

Count 4:

S. Dev Dley on or about December 11, 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia, denied internationally protected persons Zsuzsanna Holland, defence of jurisdiction, willfully and unlawfully, committed the indictable offence of Obstructing justice, contrary to Section 139 (2) of the Criminal Code.

Count 5:

S. Dev Dley between August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia aided and abetted Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston's crimes by refusing to remove Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston from matter 105848, permitting Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston to continue as counsel of record in matter 105848 subsequent to being informed of criminal charges sworn against Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston on August 8, 2019 in private prosecution matter 36218-1, unlawfully and willfully committed the Indictable offence of aiding contrary to Section 21(1)(b) of the Criminal Code.

Count 6:

S. Dev Dley between August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia omitted to remove Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston as counsel of record in Kamloops matter 105848 when Timothy A. Livingston had been accused of 8 counts of Code violations in Williams Lake Private Prosecution 36218-1 thereby unlawfully and willfully committed the Indictable offence of omitting contrary to Section 21(1)(c) of the Criminal Code.

Count 7:

S. Dev Dley between August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia aided and abetted Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston's crimes by refusing to remove Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston from matter 105848, permitting Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston to continue as counsel of record in matter 105848 subsequent to being informed of criminal charges sworn against Crown counsel Timothy A. Livingston on August 8, 2019 in private prosecution matter 36218-1, unlawfully and willfully committed the Indictable offence of abetting contrary to Section 21(2) of the Criminal Code.

Count 8:

S. Dev Dley between August 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia threatened and unlawfully and willfully prosecuted of internationally protected person Zsuzsanna Holland, unlawfully and willfully committed the Indictable offence of Threats against internationally protected person, contrary to Section 2 and Section 424 of the Criminal Code.

Count 9:

S. Dev Dley between January 2019 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia deliberately ignored, defied and subverted Chilcotin Minister of Justice, Fanny Stump's authority over case 105848 and dismissal of charges, unlawfully and willfully prosecuted Zsuzsanna Holland thereby committed the Indictable offence of Contempt of court, disobeying a court order, contrary to Section 9 (c) and 127(1) of the Criminal Code.

Count 10:

S. Dev Dley between September 2020 forward, near Williams Lake in the Province of British Columbia, and other locations in the Province of British Columbia deliberately ignored, defied and subverted First Law of the Land Sovereign Tribunal authority over case 105848 and dismissal of charges, unlawfully and willfully prosecuted Zsuzsanna Holland thereby committed the Indictable offence of Contempt of court, disobeying a court order, contrary to Section 9 (c) and 127(1) of the Criminal Code.

Count 11:

S. Dev Dley on or about September 22nd, 2020 issued an arrest warrant against internationally protected person Zsuzsanna Holland near Williams Lake, in the Province of British Columbia and other locations in the Province of British Columbia, willfully and unlawfully committed the indictable offence of kidnapping, contrary to Section 279(1)(1.1)(a.1) of the Criminal Code.

Count 12:

S. Dev Dley between October 9th, 2020 forward held and detained and confined internationally protected person Zsuzsanna Holland at Williams Lake and Prince George, in the Province of British Columbia willfully and unlawfully committed the indictable offence of hostage taking, contrary to Section 279.1(2)(a.1) of the Criminal Code.
