With the alarming rate that these inmates are doped up on K2, does it ever occurred to anyone of you all that it only takes one inmate to assault you and your colleagues would not be able to respond in enough time to assist you and save your life. Just recently you had this idiot they call Swole who was high on K2 and assaulted a female officer. She was fortunate that other inmates came to her assistance or the situation could have been fatal.

You all expected that you will be respected, but respect is earned and not given. Every day, you all come in with these nefarious dispositions and seem to not be happy unless you are cursing at an inmate or just harassing inmates for things that are not in Chapter 33. You want inmates to follow rules and regulations, yet you all violate the rules daily. You females seem to think that its OK to punish the whole dorm because you are upset at a few inmates for not locking down quick enough or because someone's bed isn't made up.

I personally have never used any profane language or reveling remarks when addressing any of the prison guards. Neither have I violated any rules or regulations and yet, I am incessantly being locked down, being deprived of canteen and being prohibited to contact my family on a consistent basis because of the actions of others that you are making me pay for.

For those of you who just enjoy doing ignorant and asinine things such as:

1. Locking our doors to feed us and further delaying the delivery of the trays while they get colder
2. After 5 pm still trying to make inmates be in Class A's, which is contrary to chapter 33
3. Intentionally messing up count, to keep us caged in like animals, for 2 or 3 hours.
4. Cursing at inmates daily, in violation of Chapter 33.208.002(8)
5. Not running Canteen weekly, as required by Chapter 33.203.101(2)
6. Being grossly out of shape, in violation of Chapter 33. 208.002(3)(a), when you are supposed to be PHYSICALLY FIT.

My questions to you are:

1. Does it make you feel more of a man or a woman to curse someone out?
2. Does it make you feel important to tell an inmate to put on Class A's just to eat?
3. Does it make you feel powerful to tell grown men to lock down in their cells?
4. Does it make you females feel like you are more powerful than a man because of your job?
5. Do you really feel inmates obey you because they respect you or because they just trying to go home?
6. Does it make you feel tingly inside when you take something away from an inmate?
7. Does it give you joy to cause other people mental anguish and emotional distress?
8. Do you think it's a coincidence that most prison guards can't find a good man or woman to be their spouse?
9. Do you think it's a coincidence that prison guards and police officers have the highest domestic violence, alcohol and substance abuse than any other profession?
10. Do you females enjoy seeing all these different men everyday?
11. Is the reason you work here is because you have a fetish for criminals, because you are criminal yourselves, but just have a different uniform?
12. Do you not think that the bible is true and that you won't reap what you sow?
13. Do you not understand the mistreatment you committed against inmates, will manifest in your home and social life?
14. Do you not comprehend that on judgment day you will have to give an account for EVERY unkind word, action or deed you committed against anyone?
15. Do you think by doing all these nefarious things to inmates, that you will get a promotion and advance your career (if you can call counting heads 4 times a day a career)?
16. Do any of you really think you are tough or do you know you are soft as cotton and hide behind the fact that you have a gang to jump on an inmate, if you feel threatened?
17. Do you not comprehend that real men and women don't have to belittle others to make themselves feel good or important.
18. Do you not comprehend that your white colleagues laugh at you, all behind closed doors, because they are entertained by your ghetto dispositions, while you all stay in the lowest positions while they advanced.

It is expedient for most of you that these things apply to change your ways and start presenting yourselves like someone who is intelligent and have a sense of morality and professionalism. I would also advise all of you to do just a little research on me and who I am and what my profession was on the outside. I am not a criminal, inmate nor convict.
