Color Guard:

Needs for this year: Looking at clearance flags. Want to buy 20 flags. Need new silver poles. Majorette uniforms cost \$80-150 and must buy at least 5. Recurring fund for flags approved previously. Wants a new set of 20 standard flag for \$16 each would be \$320. Asking to do 10. Swing flags \$920.
