

# Business Partner Spotlight: Almost Home

Almost Home is a family owned business created by Lutz native Natalie Zambito Nelson. Almost Home is a fully licensed facility that has just begun its 9th year of business. Almost Home offers a wide range of child care. After School Care is designed for grades Kindergarten through 5th grade for \$60.00 per week. The After School Program focuses on having the children complete their homework before they start the variety of indoor and outdoor activities daily. These activities include Air Hockey, Wii Games, Art, Board Games, Football, Basketball, Field Hockey etc. The After School Program closes at 6:30 PM to give parents ample time to leave work and pick up their children without feeling rushed.

The Child Sitting Program gives parents of children ages 3 years old to 13 years old a chance to have an evening out on Friday and Saturday nights. The Child Sitting Program is membership based for children not enrolled in our After School program. We have 2 memberships available a One Use per Month for \$30.00 and The Unlimited for \$59.00 per month. Both memberships cover up to 2 children. For children enrolled in our After School program, the cost is \$15 per evening per child. The Summer Program also accepts children ages 3 to 13. The summer program is packed with exciting field trips, special guests, and activities. This program is designed to keep kids engaged all day long by rotating them to the various activities every 45 minutes.

Almost Home also offers an academically and socially focused VPK Program designed to get your 4 year old ready for Kindergarten. This program offers various rollover times to accommodate every parent's needs.

The center has a child capacity of 113 students and maintains an 18:1 staff to child ratio for the After School, Child Sitting and Summer Camp Programs and a 1:10 ratio for the VPK Program.
