

The Spartan 300 is a challenging, 10 stage, all steel pistol and PCC match. The goal of the competitor is to achieve the 30 points for each stage and to attain all 300 points for the match as quickly as possible. Each stage will consist of 25 targets worth 1 point each and 1 bonus target worth 5 points. The targets will consist of reactive steel targets that will range in size from 3" to 12" and distance from 8 to 40 yards. Each stage will have its own par time depending on the complexity of the stage.

- Divisions for the match are based on Common Pistol Competitions, with a few modifications. Open and Limited are not changed. Production can load 15 rounds per magazine, and SS are allowed to have 10 round magazines. A magwell is allowed for CO and pistol braces are allowed for PCC. Major and minor power factors do not apply, but calibration zones on reactive targets will be calibrated for 9mm minor power factor.
- Competitors carrying their handgun in a holster must have an empty magazine well, and the hammer or striker must be de-cocked. Anyone found in violation of this rule will be immediately escorted by a Range Officer to a suitable safety area where appropriate corrective action shall be made. PCC must have a chamber flag or empty chamber indicator when not in ready condition.
- For PCC, each stage will require a minimum of 1 magazine reload. No side by side magazine couplers allowed. Magazines must be carried on the belt or in apparel pockets. No restriction on location on the belt. No thigh rigs or tie down magazine holders. End to end coupling/extension is allowed. PCC allowable calibers are 9mm, .357Sig, .40S&W, 10mm, and .45ACP.
- All external safeties must be engaged after shooter makes ready, and before the start signal.
- Matchbook stage images are close renderings of how the stage will look. Type of target and actual placements of targets and props depend on MD discretion.







- Teams will compete in 4 stages for their competition. Two match stages will be designated as team stages, as well as two team only stages.
- Each team will consist of 4 different team members. Only 3 members of each team will compete in each of the team stages, but a teammate cannot sit out more than once.
- 2 stages will be relay type stages, and 2 stages will be 3 teammates on the firing line.
- Each team can consist of only 1 PCC and 1 Open division shooter. All other slots can be filled with any other division. PCC and Open are not required for teams.
- Teams will shoot 2 stages during the lunch break and 2 stages after the match completion each day.
- Team entry is \$20.00. Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.







- Reshoots of stages will only be granted for stage malfunction, or RO interference.
- Ammo, equipment, or shooter error will not constitute a reshoot of a stage.
- A mulligan will be available to be purchased for a reshoot of a stage.
- Shooters can only purchase 1 mulligan per registration.
- Mulligans can be purchased before the match and during the match. Once the shooter tells the RO they want to use their mulligan, they cannot reverse their decision.
- If the shooter finishes a stage and did not achieve the result they had hoped for, the shooter has until the stage is reset to decide if they want to "cash in" their mulligan for a reshoot.
- Reshoots will take place after all squad members have shot the stage.

Mulligans will cost \$20.00 per registration








BAY 1 Scott Wilson, Dennis Parham, Derek Aarseth, Darryl Vancil

START POSITION: Standing outside of shoot area with toes touching black marks on

faultline. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Engage targets from within shoot area.








BAY 2 Brandon Creps, Chelsie Creps, Shane Hammond, Terry Creps

START POSITION: Standing with both heels touching black marks on rear faultline. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Engage targets from within shoot areas or shoot boxes.







BAY 3 Ryan Claspille, Kevin Wedemeyer, Cameron Wright


START POSITION: Standing in center shoot box. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Hit popper, move to other shoot boxes and engage same color targets. Engage



next popper from any shoot box and engage same color targets. Engage final popper from any shoot box and engage same color targets.

Bonus target can only be engaged from center shoot box when visible. Shooter must engage color coded plates after each popper is hit Once next color popper is hit, shooter cannot return to previous color Procedural penalty for hitting wrong color On deck shooter will be standing in on deck circle waiting their turn



START POSITION: Shoot box on far right, 10 yds from targets. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Engage target array directly down range from shoot box. Move to next shoot box and repeat



Bonus target can only be engaged from center shoot box Procedural penalty for every shot taken outside of shoot box On deck shooter will be standing in on deck circle waiting their turn






BAY 5 Mark Goede, Tom Buehrle, Nathan Buehrle

START POSITION: Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready. Standing in START box.

AT SIGNAL: Move to shoot area and engage all targets from within shoot area. Hit on door frame is procedural penalty.









BAY 7 Shane Moody, Curt Ford, Russ Braunseis


START POSITION: Standing with both feet on yellow disc inside of NO-SHOOT area. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.



AT SIGNAL: Engage targets from within shoot area and

shoot boxes. Blue targets must be engaged from blue shoot box. Red targets must be engaged from red shoot box. White targets can be engaged from anywhere in delta other than colored shoot boxes or start area.

Bonus target can be engaged **anytime** it is visible from within shoot area or shoot box. Procedural penalty for every shot taken from wrong color shoot box On deck shooter will be standing in on deck circle waiting their turn








BAY 9 Eric Zachman, Chris Bible, Todd Fender

START POSITION: Standing with toes touching marks on faultline. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Engage targets from within shoot area.







START POSITION: Standing with toes touching black mark on rear faultline. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.



AT SIGNAL: Engage targets from within shoot area.






BAY 11 David Euson, Steve Jewett, Steve Kerr

START POSITION: Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered. PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready. Standing in start box. Start box is **not** a shoot box.

AT SIGNAL: Engage all targets as they become visible.. All knock-over targets are engaged from balance beams only. Plate rack arrays are engaged from shoot boxes only.



Bonus target can be engaged anytime it's visible from balance beams or shoot boxes. Ground contact while firing a round from balance beam is a procedural. Shooters may not use walls to support themselves while engaging from balance beam. On deck shooter will be standing in on deck circle waiting their turn





BAY 12 Randall Gustafson, Brendan Smith, Jeff Duckworth, Lisa Gustafson


START POSITION: Feet touching start stick behind shoot boxes. Handgun loaded to division capacity and holstered.

PCC loaded and shouldered, low ready.

AT SIGNAL: Engage same color targets as shoot box color. Move to next shoot box color of choice and engage same color targets. Move to final shoot box and engage same color targets.



Bonus target can be engaged **anytime** it is visible from within shoot box. Procedural penalty for hitting wrong color target Procedural penalty for each shot taken with one foot touching outside of shoot box On deck shooter will be standing in on deck circle waiting their turn
