Is it just me, or is the year, already flying by? Maybe it's just the déjà vu of Chiefs vs. the 49ers in the Super Bowl or the prospects of another Trump vs. Biden election, but my sense of time has gotten all screwed up. Because it seems like just yesterday we took down Christmas decorations and yet, today, I'm writing to invite you to celebrate Lent, the season of preparing for Easter, with FCC. This year our theme is *Easter: the Story Continues as the Journey Begins*. Similar to our Advent that reminded us the story of Christmas continues in our lives, so too, the story of Easter continues in us as we journey with Jesus. To help us journey, we have a few tools to support and guide you.

One of the most valuable tools to enrich our journey is our daily devotional. This year, our devotion comes from our denomination's publishing house, Chalice Press. It's entitled Rest & Resilience and each week you'll read about different scriptures and the spiritual practices that accompany them. Our Sunday morning worship will overlap with some of the scriptures and the week's practice. You also might notice that the authors are pastors in our tradition who are Bethany Fellows or alumni, including myself! The Bethany Fellows are a ministry partner FCC financially supports whose mission is to serve congregations by helping young pastors transition from seminary to sustained ministry. It's a joy to share this with you in hopes that it makes this season special to you.

Back, by popular demand, are mid-week gatherings that build on our theme and text. This year, we'll have Lectio Lenten Suppers, Wednesday evenings from 5:30-7, when we will join together with some soup and fellowship before praying through scripture in the ancient practice of lectio divina. It's something you have to experience! And you might be wondering, well, when is Lent? Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, Feb 14th (that's right, Valentine's Day). We'll have the Lectio Lenten Supper at 5:30 and worship will begin at 7. Ash Wednesday is one of the most moving and special moments of worship in the liturgical calendar, so I hope you don't miss out. Lent continues through Maundy Thursday, March 28, and Good Friday, March 29 (both of which have worship at 7), and we'll celebrate the resurrection of hope on Easter morning March 31st!

So, between our worship, our Lectio suppers, the special worship opportunities and the chances to give back and support our EASTER: neighbors through our Outreach drive events, I hope your Lenten journey will help you live the sentiment that : the Story Continues as the Journey Begins.



We have not offered training in over 3 years, therefore everyone needs to go through training again. Please try to attend this meeting either in person or virtually!



Thanks for your dedication to helping us be a safe and welcoming church for our kids to grow in their faith journey!


