Usually in this article space I write to you about something from our church's recent past to reflect on, or I share about an upcoming ministry that I hope is in your future plans. But today, I want to take this space to write about presence...I know you just got done with Christmas, but I want to be clear, I'm not talking about presents, rather presence. Which, really is, in its own way, an invaluable gift.

Or so I'm told.

Because I really struggle to be present to the moment, in the here and now. In fact, in the time it took me to type this far, I've been distracted with 7 texts, 3 calls, two dogs who think they'll die without being constantly petted and I actually had to stop once to pick up a kiddo who didn't get on the bus they were supposed to after school. No wonder, if you're anything like me, your thoughts are about replaying past events or thinking about the next thing coming up in the future. How often are we *really* in the present, as fully mentally and spiritually in the same place as our body is?

Not only does being distracted make us spend a lot of time collecting our thoughts as we're constantly pivoting in our brains, and regardless of the scientific studies that show effective multitasking is actually a myth; but as Christians, our faith calls us to be present. It might still be the Christmas season when you read this, a season that is all about when God decides to teach us and save us by being present with us! And even in his birth, Jesus is calling us to work on our presence—think of Mary who is said to have "pondered everything in her heart", the shepherds simply show up and the Magi are so dedicated to being present to what is happening in that moment that they trek across a desert just to be here and now.

As we begin a new year, I hope it will be a year where you can receive and give the gift of presence. To let go of the idolatry of efficiency, to put down the phone at the dinner table, to spend many days going on long walks, marveling at God's Creation and building relationships with those you're privileged to share this life with.

I'm sure throughout this year, we'll talk about specific spiritual practices to help us learn and model the discipline of presence. But if you want suggestions *right now* of some ways, I would start not only with the phone, walking and relationship-building ideas I've already discussed, but to check out *lectio divinia* (a way of praying scripture—I use the Ritual app for their daily lectio), explore and practice "mindful eating" and work on your active listening skills.

I would say that we will cover all these things and more in worship or small groups, but right now, I'm just going to celebrate and give thanks for today. And I hope you will too.






