
#### GOOD FRIDAY'S GUIDING VIRTUES

Our school celebrated the Haritha Haram, a special event aimed at promoting environmental awareness and the importance of greenery in our lives.




#### INDEPENDENCE DAY


#### CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION


#### SCIENCE EXHIBITION




