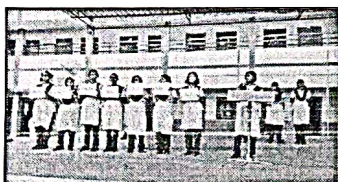
School Events :

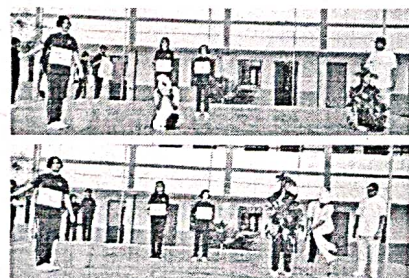

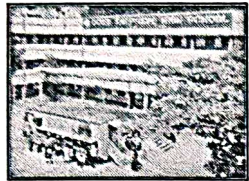
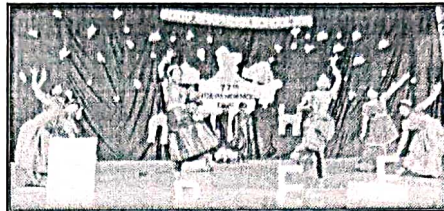


Middle School and High School students organized a value-based skit as part of the celebration. It was both educational and humorous.

ingenuity and the boundless possibilities of exploration. It was a moment of unity, inspiration, and awe-inspiring wonder that left an indelible mark on us all.

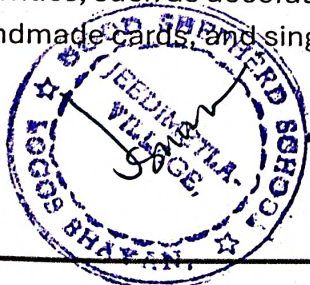
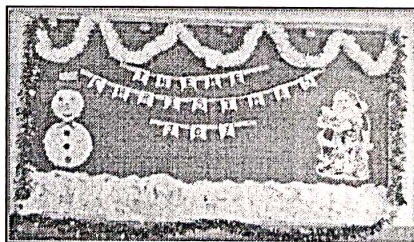

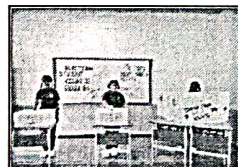
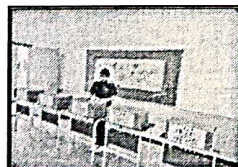
National Science Day, was honoured with science exhibition, showcasing innovative projects by students. These exhibitions encourage scientific curiosity featuring experiments and models.

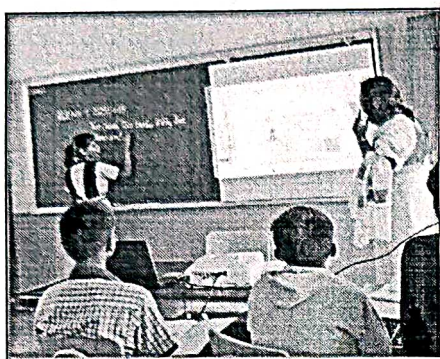


Student Corner :



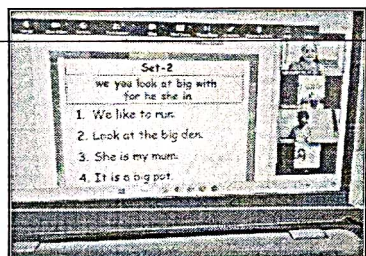
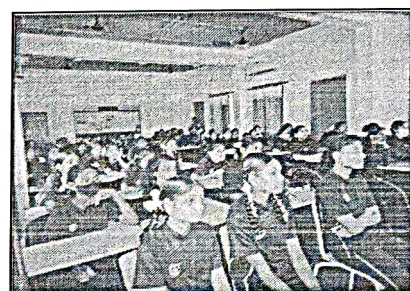

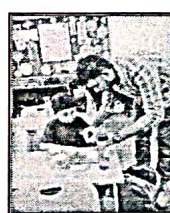
Inclusive Education :

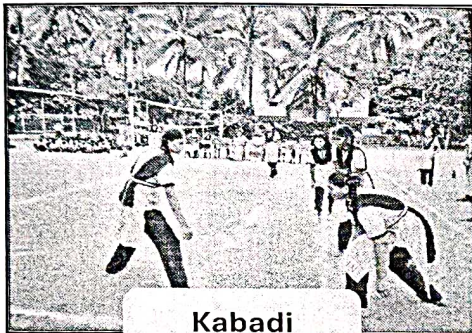

Clubs :

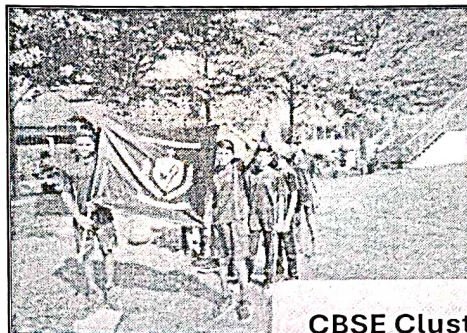

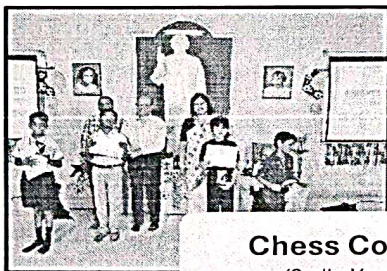

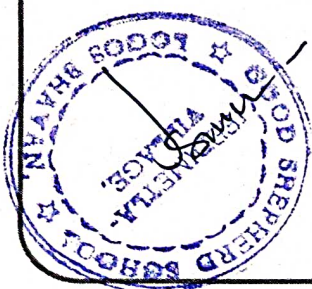


Chess Competition
(SadhuVasvani School)

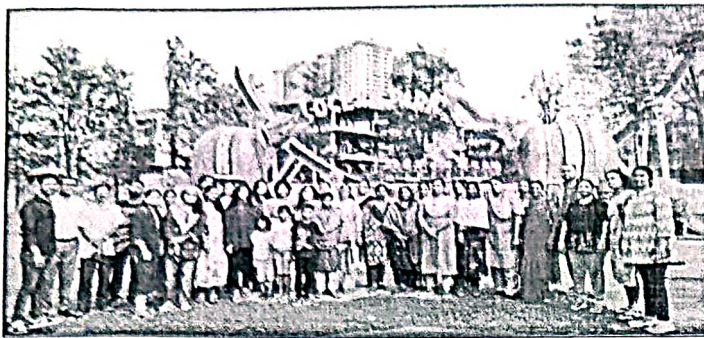

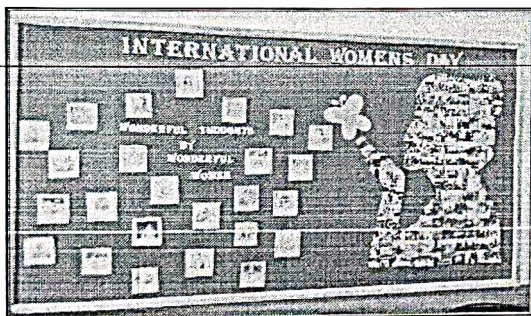

Professional Development :

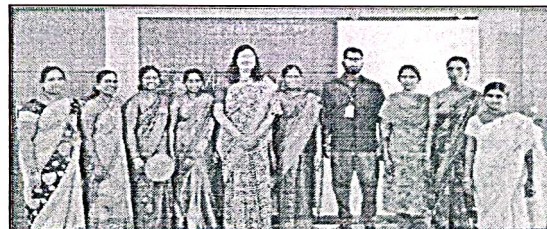
