The song first took form in Tomlin's heart and mind as he mediated on scripture. "I remember sitting on my sofa in my little apartment. And Psalm 104 was the psalm I was looking at. It said, 'You, our Lord, are very great.'

All Who Believe and Are Baptized

This is a short hymn about baptism and Christian unity in diversity. It is sometimes described as a foundational Lutheran hymn, and is based on an original work written by Danish poet and clergyman, Thomas Hansen Kingo in 1524.

Jesu, Jesu, Fill Us With Your Love

"Jesu, Jesu" is Colvin's most popular hymn. The melody is adapted from a Ghanaian folk song he heard during his years of service in that country. The tune name "CHEREPONI" comes from a town in northern Ghana, where the hymn was written.

Jesus Love Me

"Jesus Loves Me" is a Christian hymn written by Anna Bartlett Warner 1827–1915). The lyrics first appeared as a poem in the context of an 1860 novel called <u>"Say and Seal", written by her older sister Susan Warn-</u> er (1819–1885), in which the words were spoken as a comforting poem to a dying child.




