### **Photographers**

- Students may submit 1 photograph.
- Limited digital manipulation is allowed.
- Only two-dimensional (2-D), unframed artwork will be accepted.
- Students must provide a hard copy as well as upload their photograph with the application form to the email below.

# Authors

- Students may submit an 1 piece, 500 words maximum.
- Can be creative writing, anecdotes, essays etc.
- Please submit via WORD document.
- Pieces will be evaluated based on theme originality, interpretation, composition and grammar.
- Pieces must be written in English.
- Email piece to the email below.

#### **Eligibility**

- Entrants must be ages 13-18 before April 1, 2023.
- Entrants must reside in Chandler.

#### **Awards Announcement**

- Results will be announced in April by email to the student and their teacher.
- Winning entries will be posted on our websites.

#### Classic Art

- Dimensions must not exceed 20in x 32in.
- Students may enter 1 piece of 2D art only, unframed.

## Poets

- Students may submit a poem, 200 words maximum.
- Please submit via WORD document.
- Poems will be evaluated based on theme originality, interpretation, composition and grammar.
- Poem must be written in English.
