FROM THE DESK OF THE TREASURER



Brothers: Finally 2023 has ended. It was not a very financial stable year, we realized some reduction in the value of the Valley's portfolio. Fortunately though, in the last couple of months the Market got back on track. At the end of the year the Valley realized an income of \$32,000 — a sign that the portfolio is regaining some of our losses.

The Executive Board is concentrating on recruitment and building membership in the Valley. Over the last six Reunions we have averaged 10 new members. If any Brother has a suggestion on this subject please send them to a member of the Executive Board for consideration.

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, we will be raising the Per Capita Tax in line with the Supreme Council's increases, set out as follows: 2024 by \$1 to \$31, then 2025 through 2028 raised by \$1 per year until the Per Capita Tax will be reach \$35 in 2028.

We have received a communication from the SGIG suggesting to include the Per Capita in the yearly dues. This will increase our dues to \$185. It has been necessary to do this because of the increased cost of doing business.

To our Perpetual and Life Members: Once again, the Executive Board will be reaching out to you our Perpetual and Life Members of the Valley to voluntary, donate toward the Per Capita Taxes. For those who have donated over the years we thank you and look forward to your continued loyalty and support.


