VI. Treasurer's Report from Nancy Muklewicz

As of January 1^{st} , I have taken on the position of treasurer for the AAEGV. A big thanks to Bob Packheiser who held the position for so many years for his service to the Association. I know that I can on Bob's support as I take on this role and I am grateful for that.

Historically, the AAEGV's fiscal year began on June 1^{st} . the EGV Park District's (EGVPD) begins on January 1^{st} . To bring the AAEGV's fiscal year in line with the EGVPD's, in 2024 the AAEGV will migrate to a fiscal year beginning on January 1^{st} to match that of the EGVPD. This means that dues will be collected for this season only, for the period of June 1^{st} through December 31^{st} , 2023 and then again on January 1^{st} , 2024 for the entire fiscal year. The dues for this year (6/01-12/31/23) will be adjusted downwards accordingly.

A review of the EGVPD budget for 2023 shows two important things:

- 1) The Art Centre Show (Fall Juried Show) is a separate EGVPD program, so it is not a part of the AAEGV budget. Perhaps obviously, it is in the AAEGV's interest to support the Art Centre to ensure that it continues. This will be discussed in depth closer to the fall show.
- 2) As budgeted, the AAEGV would incur a net loss, The Board has decided to increase the entry fee for the Trees Exhibit to \$15 for members/\$20 non-members to ensure that the budgeted expenses are covered.

When the AAEGV merged with the EGVPD, thus becoming a program of the EGVPD, the Association surrendered about \$1,700.00 to the EGVPD. As of August, 2022; \$1,371.09 remained in our account. That figure dropped to \$700.21 as of 12/31/22. I have requested information from Deanna Rafida (our EGVPD liaison) to try to trace the disposition of these funds. My concern that once this "cushion" is gone, it could negatively impact our organization.

One last thing before everyone's eyes glaze over completely. Because the EGVPD keeps its financial records on an accrual basis (which is not conducive to producing a financial report), I am going to work with the Board to manually track things so I can produce numbers that I hope are meaningful to us. In other words, my future reports will be less wordy and contain more numbers. Thank you for your patience!
