

A) Future AAEGV Library Exhibits - Monthly Themes

These exhibit themes for members can be interpreted in any manner you wish. If you have work you would like to exhibit and it does not quite fit the theme, that's okay, bring it in!

B) Annual Trees Juried Show

Our annual Trees Juried Show will take place this April at the EGV Library. An entry form has been attached to the email, but here are some highlights:

1) One piece of art may be submitted by a member/non-member and trees must be the primary subject matter.



- 2) Entrance Fee: \$15 member/\$20 non-member
- 3) Art medium may be in oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel drawing media, or mixed media.
- 4) Cash prizes will be awarded; all art must be for sale.
- 5) Work needs to be original and must not have been shown at previous juried exhibits.
- 6) Dimensions including frame: no smaller than $8" \times 10"$ and no larger than $24" \times 30"$. Work should be suitably framed with a taut wire attached to the back.
