1) Prairie Art Center - July, 2023

The AAEGV has been invited to share their art at the Prairie Art Center Gallery in Schaumburg during the month of July. This is open to all members. You must be a current member to participate (another good idea to pay those dues by June 1st!). The *drop off will be Saturday, July 1st from 10:00-10:30 am* at the Prairie Arts Center – Herb Aigner Gallery (201 Schaumburg Court in Schaumburg, IL).

- a) An artist may submit up to 3 framed pieces depending approximately on the size: three (3) if they are small (12×16 or less), two (2) if they are mid-size (16×20), and one (1) if it is a larger piece.
- b) You will also need to include an artist statement that briefly describes the piece(s) and a short bio of the artist including: a picture of the artist, background/education, contact info/website.
- c) Please send the painting details (a picture of the piece, title, size, medium and price) to aaegvexhibits@gmail.com by Saturday, June 17th. Make sure all work is wired and ready to hang and identified on the back with the title name. Painting labels will be provided.
- d) Artist Reception for the Prairie Art Show will be Saturday, July 8th from 3-5pm.

e) There is no theme for this show, just bring your best work. Drop off will be at the Prairie Art Center from 10am-10:30am. If you have a conflict, please make arrangements with Tammy.

2) June 11th - Culture and Art in the Park in the Village Green adjacent to the EGV Library

5) August, 2023 Meeting

New this year: We will be having a Q&A session with the Board and Member Critiques for our August Meeting. Bring your questions, especially about the Juried Art Show.

Creating Original Artwork: We have had many questions about what constitutes original artwork. Original art is a piece that was generated by the artist, not copied from a published source. The question then arises about copyright-free websites like Pixabay or Unsplash. They are copyright-free and you can paint from them, but when you submit to a juried exhibit the rules usually stipulate that the artwork must be original. You could take 3 or 4 pictures from those sites and make an original painting that fuses them into an original composition, but you should not copy them exactly. Also, when you take a class and a teacher has the entire class paint one of their reference photos, that is not original art. It is always best to paint from your own original reference photos.

Our Fall Juried Art Show and the Spring Trees Exhibit both have requirements for original art. If you have additional questions on this topic, bring them to our August meeting for discussion.

D) Sunday is Fun Day!

What is **Sunday is Fun Day**? It is open studio time at the Pavilion Craft Room (due to EGPD party rentals) where you can bring your own supplies and work on anything you would like. It is available as a perk for members of AAEGV only. Share conversation, suggestions, and skills during some relaxed studio time. Hope to see you there!
