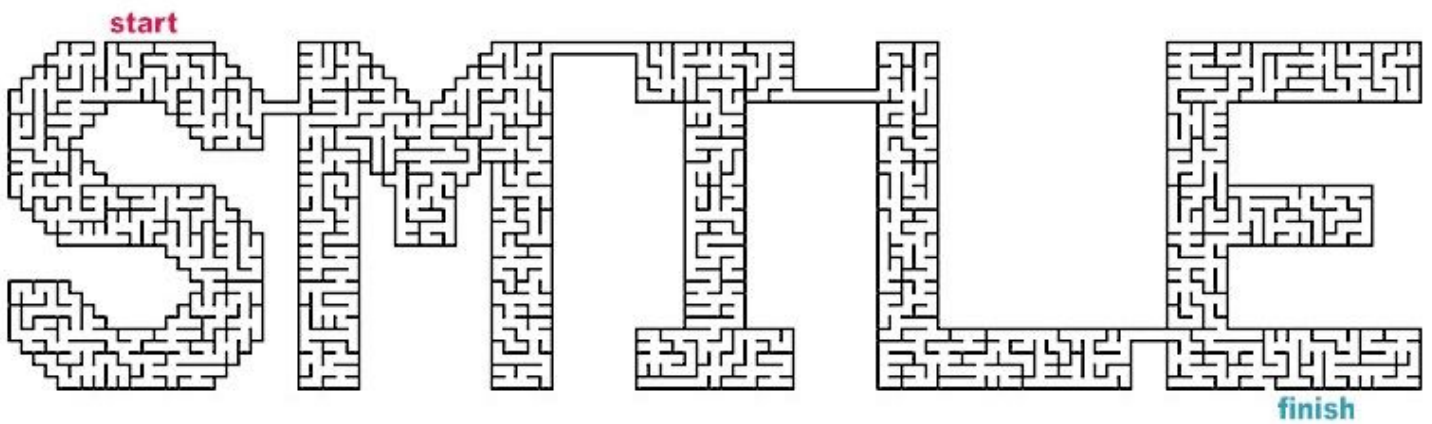

No Bake Cherry Cheesecake

Is there anything better than sitting out on an August day eating no-bake Cheesecake? Maybe the fact that it took no time at all to make!

Easy, delicious, and can be made with whatever fruit filling you wish. YUM!

Ingredients:

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ cups graham wafer crumbs

9 tbsp butter or margarine, melted

8 oz tub of Whipped topping (like Cool Whip)

$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp vanilla

$\frac{1}{3}$ cup granulated sugar

8 oz cream cheese, softened

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup powdered sugar

1 can cherry pie filling

In medium bowl, combine graham crumbs with sugar until combined. Add melted butter. Press into lightly greased 9x13 pan, pressing down firm.

Beat softened cream cheese. Add powdered sugar and vanilla. Mix with whipped topping. Spread evenly over crumb crust. Chill 30 minutes.

Evenly spoon out cherry filling over whipped topping.

Chill at least 2 hours before serving. Eat while standing to avoid calories.
