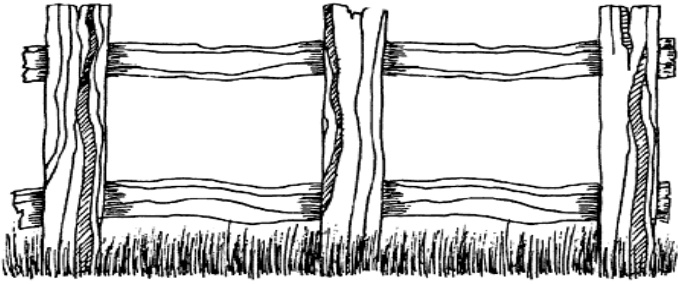

What to do in an Emergency

Emergency Information

In case of Emergency, call 911.

This information is also posted outside the store, in the entry of the laundromat, and by the pond.

This is the information that was in all Camper Handbooks given to you this spring. It is the second page. Please keep this handy, so when an emergency happens, you can reference it. An idea may be to stick it on your fridge or in a easily visible location. As noted, this information is also posted in several camp locations.

If there is an emergency and an ambulance needs to be called, having someone at the gate to lead the ambulance to your site can add precious minutes for first responders.

The camp emergency number is Rick's cell phone. If you call it, even throughout the night, we can ensure the gate is open and lead them to your site. The call button on the gate also rings to both Rick and Laura's cell phones just for emergencies.

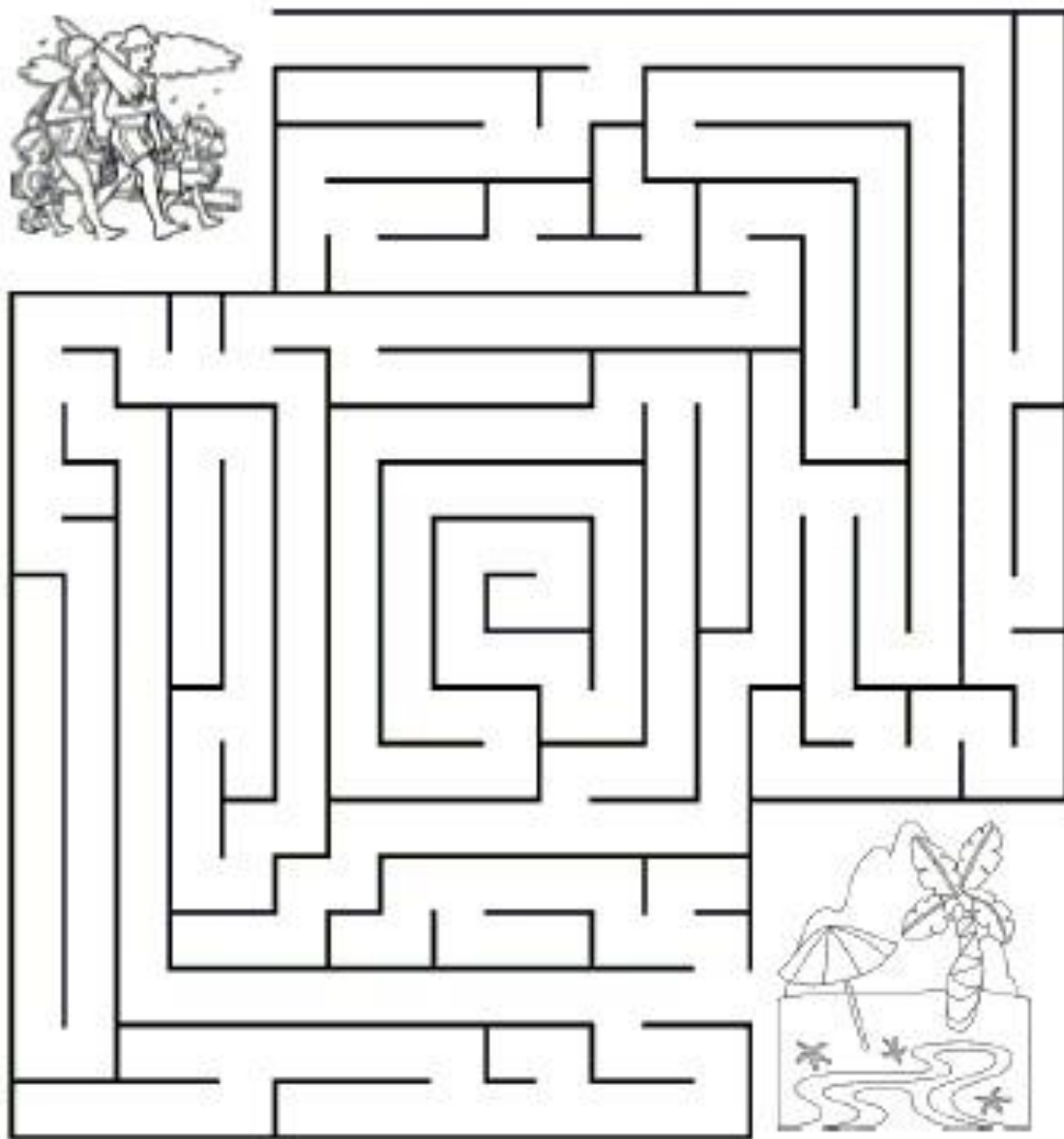
There will be a cash donation jar set up at the Cedar Rail Campground office. For all other donations you can e-transfer Bridget at stinsonbigg@live.ca.

Recipes and Tidbits

Broccoli Salad

Ingredients

- 5-6 cups broccoli florets
- 1 cup sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- $\frac{2}{3}$ cup dried cranberries
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup crumbled bacon
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup salted sunflower seeds
- $\frac{1}{3}$ cup red onion diced into small pieces



Dressing

- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup mayonnaise
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup sour cream
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Tablespoon white wine vinegar
- 3 Tablespoons sugar
- $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon salt
- $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon pepper

Instructions

1. Combine broccoli florets, cheddar cheese, dried cranberries, bacon, sunflower seeds, and onion in a large bowl.
2. In a separate, small bowl, whisk together mayo, sour cream, vinegar, sugar, salt, and pepper until smooth and well-combined.
3. Pour dressing over broccoli combination and toss or stir well.
4. Broccoli salad may be served immediately, but for best flavor refrigerate for at least one hour before serving. Make sure to toss broccoli salad thoroughly again before serving.

Keep refrigerated if not consuming right away.
