CAMPFIRE SAFETY



Please remember to be safe with your campfire:

- Wet down the grass around the fire ring regularly.
- Always have water nearby to extinguish the fire if needed.
- NEVER leave your fire unattended.
- Always watch youngsters around the fire.
- Keep your fire manageable you do not need a large fire it is hot already!
- Do not use a fire accelerant (liquid firestarter).
- Watch for sparks! It only takes a spark to ignite dry grass!
- Fully extinguish your fire before going into your trailer for the night.
