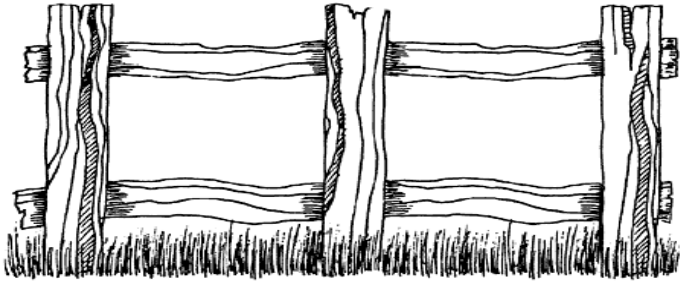

Search the Sky!

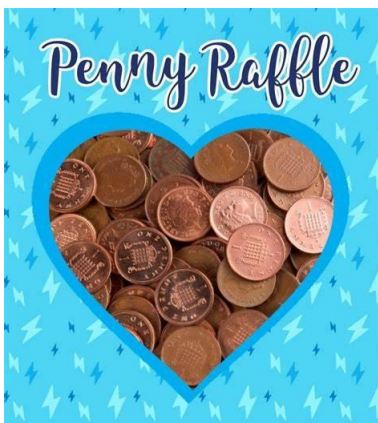
We are so lucky to have some Astronomers here at Cedar Rail!

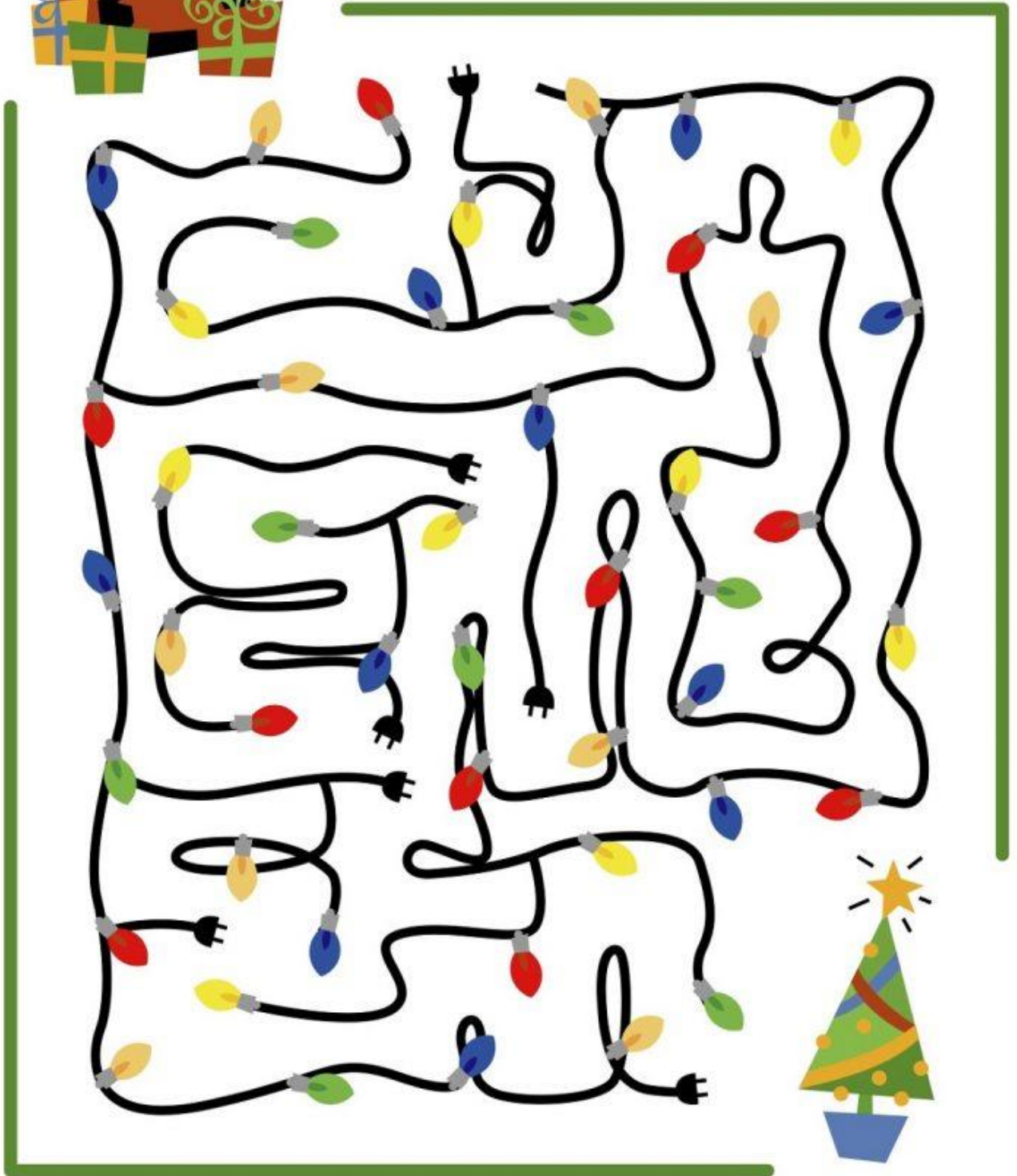

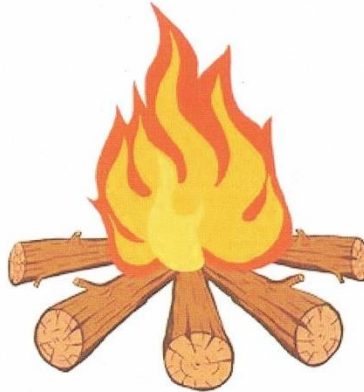

CAMPFIRE SAFETY



Please remember to be safe with your campfire:

- *Wet down the grass around the fire ring regularly.*
- *Always have water nearby to extinguish the fire if needed.*
- *NEVER leave your fire unattended.*
- *Always watch youngsters around the fire.*
- *Keep your fire manageable – you do not need a large fire – it is hot already!*
- *Do not use a fire accelerant (liquid firestarter).*
- *Watch for sparks! It only takes a spark to ignite dry grass!*
- *Fully extinguish your fire before going into your trailer for the night.*
